

Only voters registered as Democratic, Green or Republican are eligible to vote in the Presidential Preference Election. If you wish to change your party in order to vote in this election, you must update your registration no later than Monday, February 22.

If you are listed as a Permanent Early Voter, you will automatically receive a ballot by mail approximately three weeks before each election in which you are eligible to vote. If you wish to be removed from the Permanent Early Voter List, or to cancel mailing of early ballots for one or more elections, please contact the Recorder's Office at (928) 679-7860 or (800) 793-6181.

If you are NOT a Permanent Early Voter, you will receive a sample ballot before each election notifying you where your polling place is for that election.

You must update your voter registration whenever you change your residence address, name, or political party preference. Election mail is not forwardable. It is important to keep your mailing address current with our office, even if you are only temporarily away. You may change your mailing address over the phone by calling the Recorder's Office at (928) 679-7860 or (800) 793-6181.






Make the Primary Election A Primary Concern

★ Early Voting Options ★

Permanent Early Voting List (PEVL)

Any registered voter with a mailing address within Arizona may request to be placed on the Permanent Early Voter List (PEVL). **Voters on the PEVL will automatically receive an early ballot by mail for all elections in which they are eligible to participate.**

There is an option to sign up for the PEVL on the Arizona voter registration form.

Request an Early Ballot

Voters who are not on the Permanent Early Voting List may request an early ballot to be mailed to them up to 11 days before an election.

An early ballot can be requested through our website, by phone, or in writing.

Vote Early In Person

Voters may vote early in person up until the Friday before an election. Early voting is available at the Coconino County Recorder's Office as well as several other sites within the county. Please call for more information or visit our website for a complete list of early voting sites.
