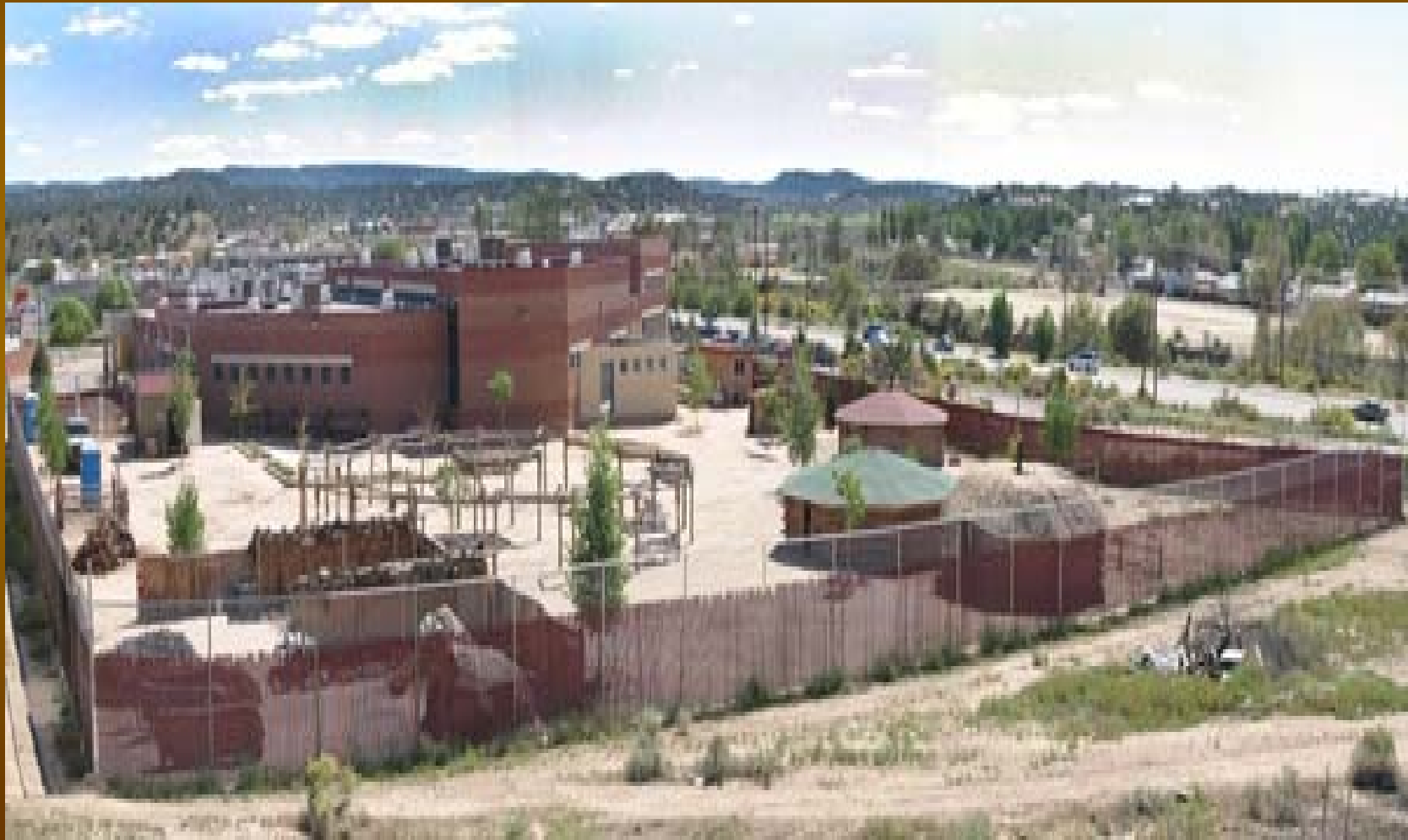



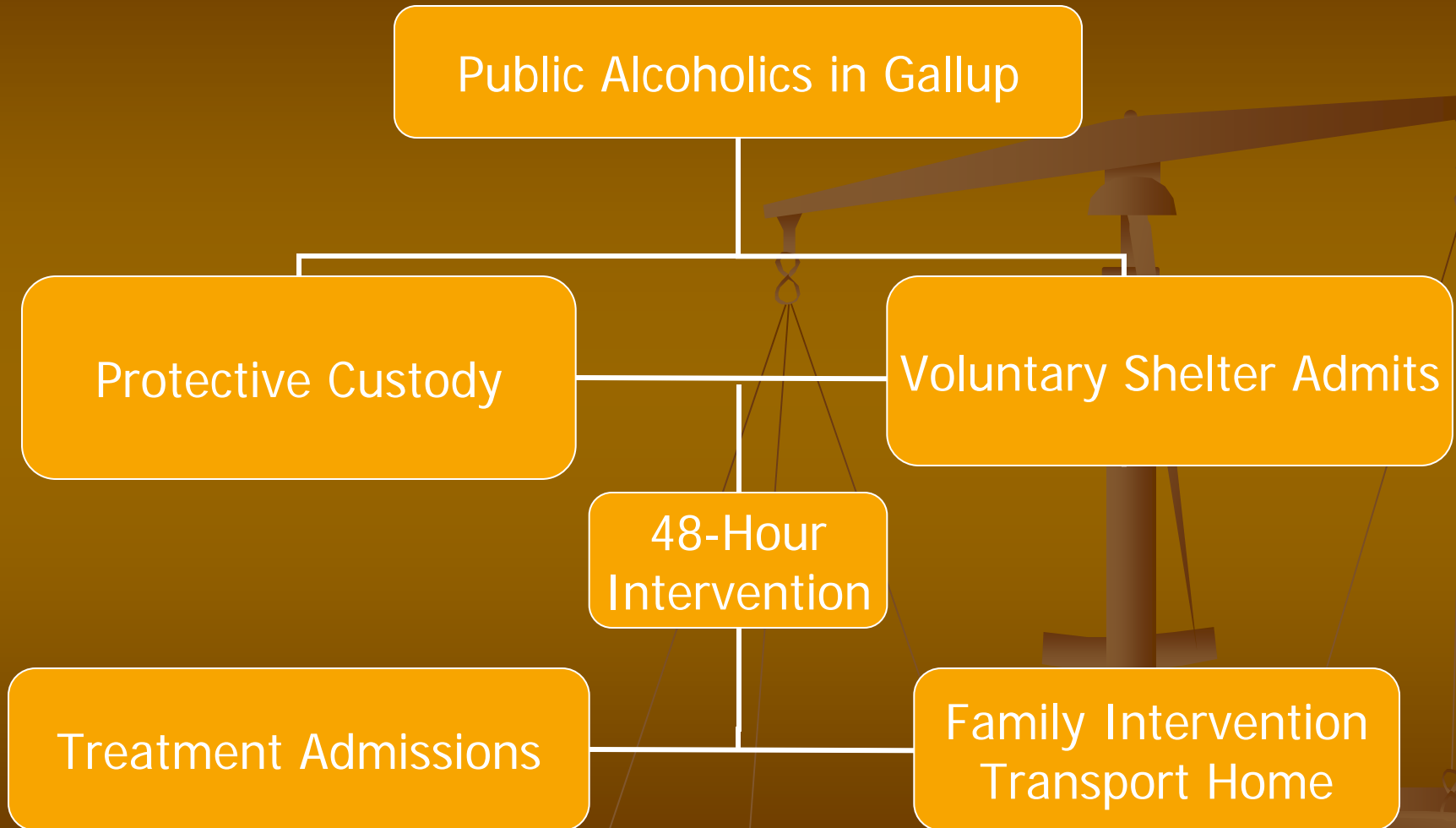

# Chronic Clients

## September 2009

- **Chronic Clients Definition:**
    - More than 100 Lifetime Admissions
    - More than 50 Admissions in Past Year
    - More than 4 Admissions in Past 30 Days
  - **373 Chronic Clients Were Admitted During September 2009**
- 

# Program Demographics



- **18,000 Residential Clients per Year, all over 19 Years Old**
- **80% Male**
- **20% Female**
- **Average Age: 46 Years**
- **80% Court Ordered or Brought in by Law Enforcement**
- **10% Referred by Agencies**
- **10% Self-Referrals**

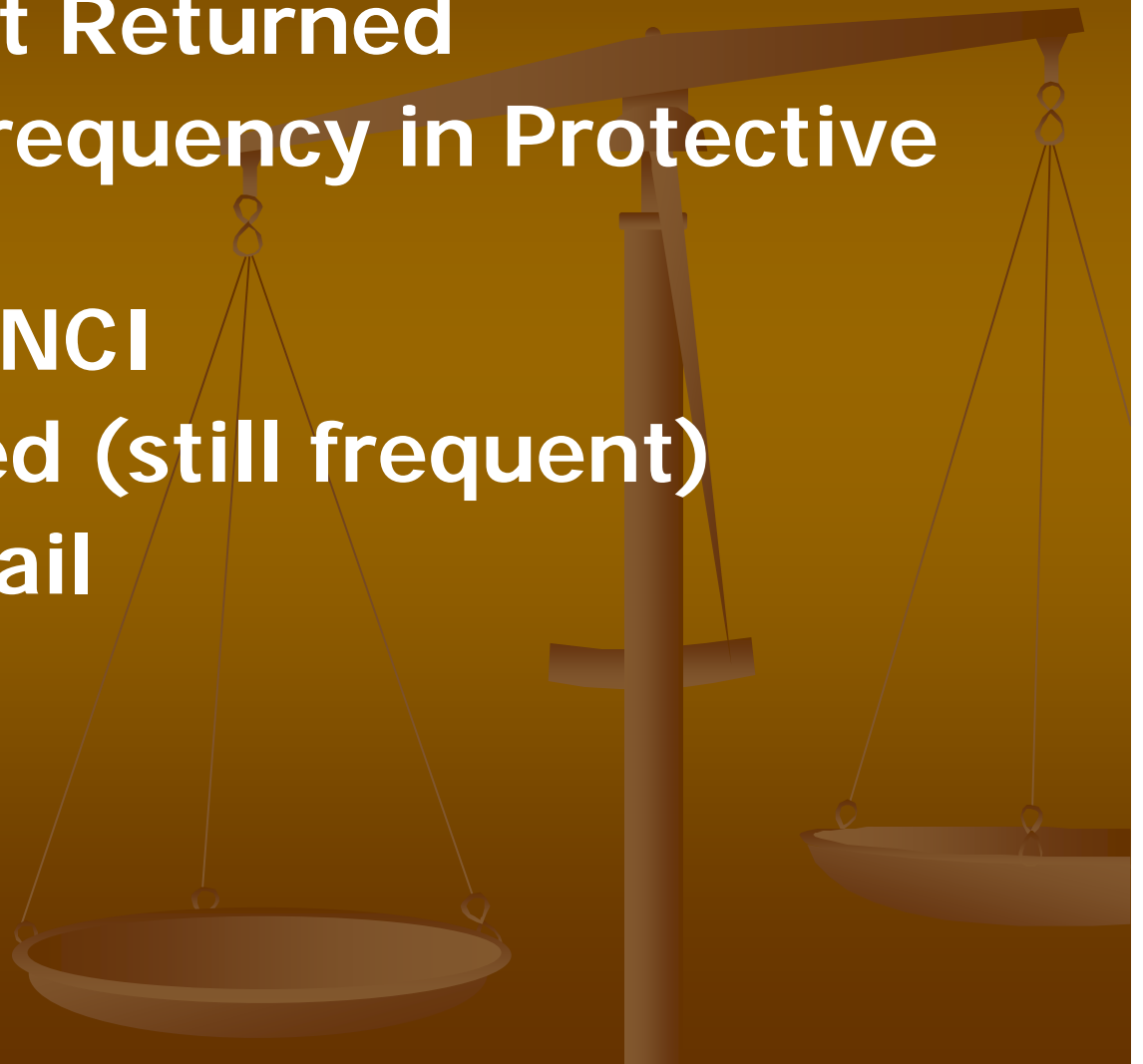

# NCI - Outcomes

- **Within Six Years of NCI's Establishment, Gallup Experienced:**
  - **50% Drop in Protective Custody Admissions**
  - **33% Drop in Alcohol-Related Emergency Room Visits**
  - **59% Drop in Alcohol-Related Accidents**
  - **50% Drop in Homicides**
  - **42% Drop in All Alcohol-Related Deaths**

# Outcomes of Clients Who Received Intervention

- 39% Have Not Returned
- 39% Lower Frequency in Protective Custody
- 12% Entered NCI
- 7% Unchanged (still frequent)
- 1% Went to Jail
- 1% Deceased
- 1% Other
