Low-Cost Rabies Vaccination Clinic

The Coconino County Health Department (CCHD) will sponsor a low-cost Rabies Vaccination Clinic on Saturday, August 15 from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm. The clinic will be located at the Coconino Humane Association, 3501 E. Butler, Flagstaff.

Flagstaff Animal Hospital will be providing rabies vaccinations for \$6.00 (dogs and cats). Fees for other vaccinations will vary. Cash only payment will be accepted.

CCHD Animal Management will be offering the opportunity to license your canine companion - \$15.00 altered; \$25.00 unaltered. Spay/neuter vouchers (\$30.00 value) will also be available for canine owners current with rabies vaccinations and licensing. Arizona State law requires all dogs to be properly vaccinated and licensed.

Rabies is an infectious disease that affects the nervous system, including the brain and spinal cord of animals and humans. It is caused by a virus present in the saliva of infected animals and is transmitted to humans through contact with the live virus.
