### **CAMPGROUND RESERVATION POLICIES FOR FORT TUTHILL COUNTY PARK:**

1. Reservations for campsites and/or the group campground at Fort Tuthill County Park are available through the Coconino County Parks and Recreation Department office located at Fort Tuthill County Park.
2. Phone-in campground reservations for Fort Tuthill County Park may be made through CCPR at (928) 679-8000 from January 2 through April 30, or directly to the Fort Tuthill County Park Campground Office at (928) 774-3464 from May 1 through September 30.
3. A reservation fee is required and does not apply toward nightly camping fees.
4. For full refund, reservation cancellations must be made prior to 7 days of first night reserved. Cancellations made with less than 7 days till first night reserved will be charged one nights' campsite fee plus the reservations fee.

### **CAMPGROUND RULES:**

1. All Coconino County Parks & Recreation (CCPR) All-Park Rules and Policies apply.

2. A single campsite may be occupied by no more than eight (8) people; and will accommodate a maximum of two (2) tents, or one (1) tent and one (1) RV.
3. The Group area is divided into four campsites. Each campsite may be occupied by no more than forty (40) people and a maximum of ten (10) tents or two (2) RV's and eight (8) tents. Group campsites may be rented together, but maximum capacity rules still apply per site.
4. Fourteen (14) consecutive days within a thirty (30) day period is the maximum stay limit in the campground. The thirty (30) day period begins on the first night of camping.
5. One (1) vehicle is the maximum number of vehicles included in the campsite cost. One (1) additional vehicle, for a total of two (2) vehicles per campsite, is allowed for an additional cost. Additional vehicles must be parked outside of the campground area.
6. Campers must keep all camping equipment within their designated campsite.
7. All campfires are restricted to fire pits and shall be no larger than two (2) feet in height.
8. Campfires must be attended to by an adult at all times and must be extinguished prior to retiring for the night and/or by midnight. Campfires must be extinguished prior to vacating the campsite.
9. Leaving dogs or pets unattended in the campground is prohibited.
10. Campers must keep campsites clean and orderly, and no trash may be deposited in fire pits.
11. Fireworks and the use of projectile propelling devices (such as paintball guns) and launching rockets is prohibited.
12. Firearms and weapons must be under lock and key and not visible at all times.

**POLICIES:**

1. Nightly camping fees shall be collected upon arrival and a paid receipt issued. Camping receipts must be displayed on site posts until departure.
2. Checks are not accepted. Cash, credit cards, debit cards travelers checks are accepted.
3. Campsites are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis, unless prior reservations are made.
4. Reservation fees (when applicable) and nightly camping fees must be paid in advance. All fees are non-refundable.
5. One (1) person from each campsite must register upon arrival. This person is responsible for any damage or cost incurred to Coconino County caused by campsite users.
6. The Campground Host has the authority to assign sites.
7. Check out time is 12:00 noon. After 12:00 noon, all sites having a receipt which expires that day, and for which no extension has been issued, are subject to and considered available for assignments to any incoming camper. Campers requesting a permit extension after 12:00 noon on the day the permit expires lose priority and will be considered with new campers.
8. Campers who have not vacated campsites by noon will be subject to another day's fees.
9. In the case of windy and/or dry conditions, a "No Fire" restriction will be imposed and remain in effect until it is deemed safe to allow campfires.
10. Quiet time shall be observed from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
11. Failure to follow all rules as set forth by CCPR may result in eviction or removal from the park.
