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**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-09**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF COCONINO COUNTY,  
ARIZONA, DESIGNATING THE POLLING PLACES AND VOTE CENTERS FOR THE  
2020 PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE ELECTION**

**WHEREAS**, the Coconino County Board of Supervisors is required by Arizona Revised Statutes (“A.R.S.”) § 16-248 to designate polling locations for the Presidential Preference Election; and

**WHEREAS**, as authorized by A.R.S. § 16-411(B)(4), the Board of Supervisors wish to provide additional convenience to voters by designating three vote centers in the County, at which any registered voters in the County will be able to choose to vote, in addition to their precinct designated polling place; and

**WHEREAS** the Board of Supervisors must designate a reasonable and adequate number of polling places for the Presidential Preference Election, but not more than one polling place for every two thousand active registered voters as of January 2, 2020;

**WHEREAS** Coconino County had 98,493 active registered voters as of January 2, 2020 and 35,787 active registered Democratic voters as of January 2, 2020.

**WHEREAS** the limitation on the number of polling locations is not applicable to locations on Native American Reservations.

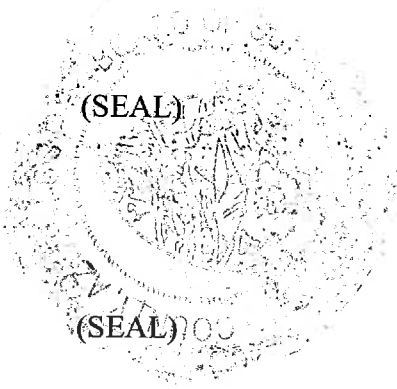
**WHEREAS** in precincts that contain fewer than three hundred (300) active registered voters for the election, Coconino County may conduct the Presidential Preference Election as ballot-by-mail.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Coconino County Board of Supervisors does hereby designate the locations listed in Exhibit “A” as vote centers, Exhibit “B” as polling places, and Exhibit “C” as ballot-by-mail precincts for the Presidential Preference Election conducted in 2020.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ALSO RESOLVED** if a polling place location needs to be changed prior to the election, the County Recorder is authorized to find an alternative location in accordance with A.R.S. § 16-411.
