RESOLUTION 2020-39

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS BETWEEN COCONINO COUNTY AND CITIES OF FLAGSTAFF, PAGE, SEDONA, AND WILLIAMS, AND THE TOWNS OF FREDONIA AND TUSAYAN FOR THE 2020 PRIMARY AND GENERAL ELECTIONS

WHEREAS, Coconino County (the "County") and the Cities of Flagstaff, Page, Sedona, and Williams, and the Towns of Fredonia and Tusayan (the "Political Subdivisions") collectively known as the "Parties" desire to enter into an Agreement for the County Recorder to conduct a Primary Election on August 4, 2020 and a General Election on November 3, 2020, if necessary dependent upon the results of their Primary Election; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. § 16-204 the governing body of any political subdivision authorized to conduct an election may enter into an agreement with a County Board of Supervisors and County Recorder for election services with the contracted cost of such elections to be a charge against the political subdivision; and,

WHEREAS, The County is willing to provide election services to the Political Subdivisions wishing to be a part of the consolidated Primary and General Elections; and

WHEREAS, these Political Subdivisions have called an election for August 4, 2020 and November 3, 2020, pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Title 16; and

WHEREAS, these Political Subdivisions wish to enter into an agreement with the County for the provision of election services subject to the terms and conditions set forth herein.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Coconino County Board of Supervisors approves the Intergovernmental Agreements between Coconino County and Cities of Flagstaff, Page, Sedona, and Williams, and the Towns of Fredonia and Tusayan.
