**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF COCONINO COUNTY,
ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE COCONINO COUNTY RECORDER TO USE
EMERGENCY VOTING CENTERS FOR THE 2020 PRIMARY ELECTION**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S") § 16-411(B)(5), the Coconino County Board of Supervisors may authorize the Coconino County Recorder to use emergency voting centers for a specified election date; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors wishes to provide emergency voting centers for the 2020 Primary Election to be located and operated at the locations and times listed in "EXHIBIT A".

WHEREAS, if any of the emergency voting centers established by the Resolution become unavailable and there is not sufficient time for the Board of Supervisors to convene to approve alternate locations and/or times, the County Recorder may make changes to the approved emergency voting locations and shall notify the public and the Board of Supervisors regarding the changes as soon as practicable; and

WHEREAS, if the County Recorder changes the emergency voting center locations listed on "EXHIBIT A", such alternate emergency voting location(s) shall be as close in proximity to the approved emergency voting locations as possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Coconino County Board of Supervisors authorizes the County Recorder to use emergency voting centers for the August 4, 2020 Primary Election.
