

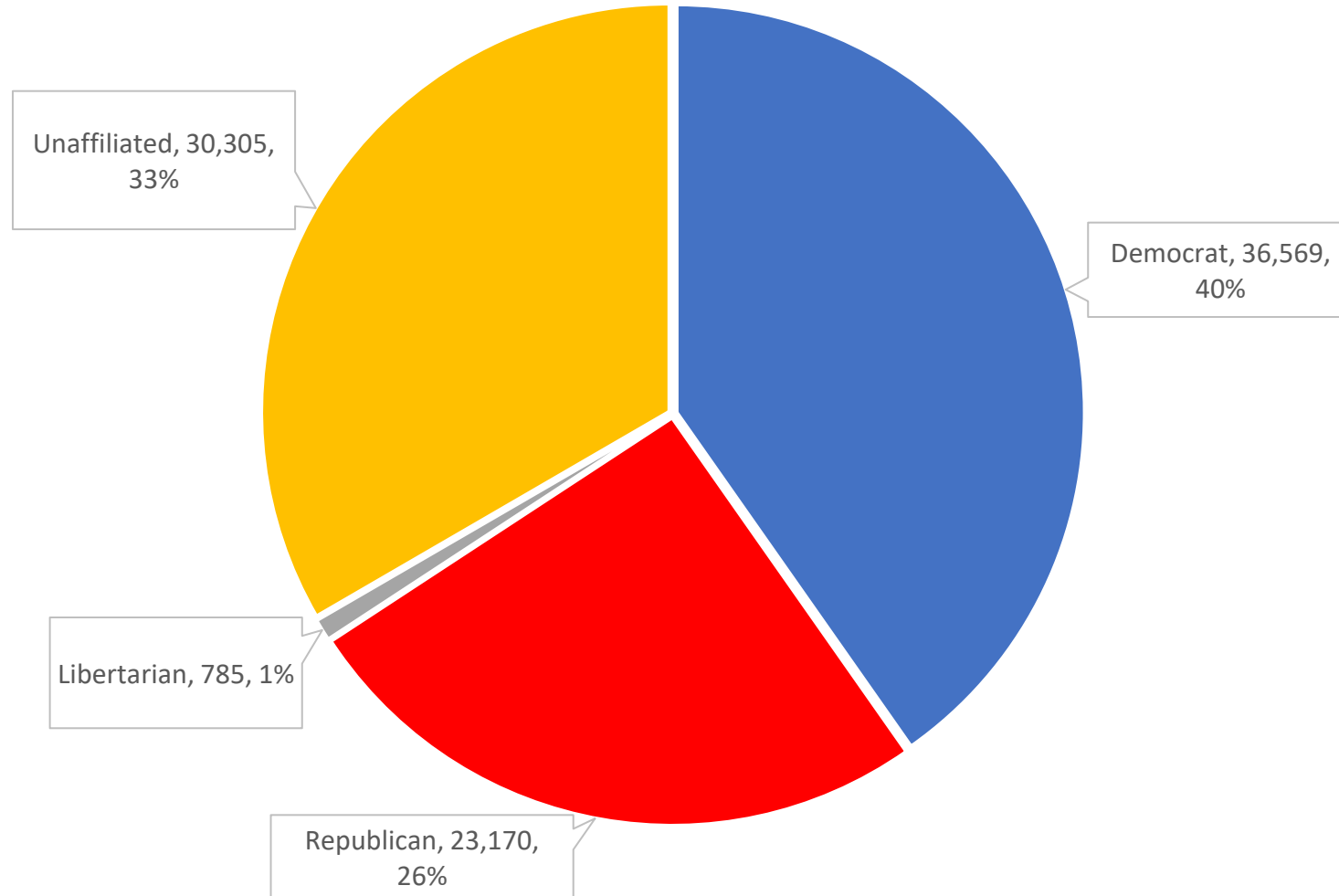

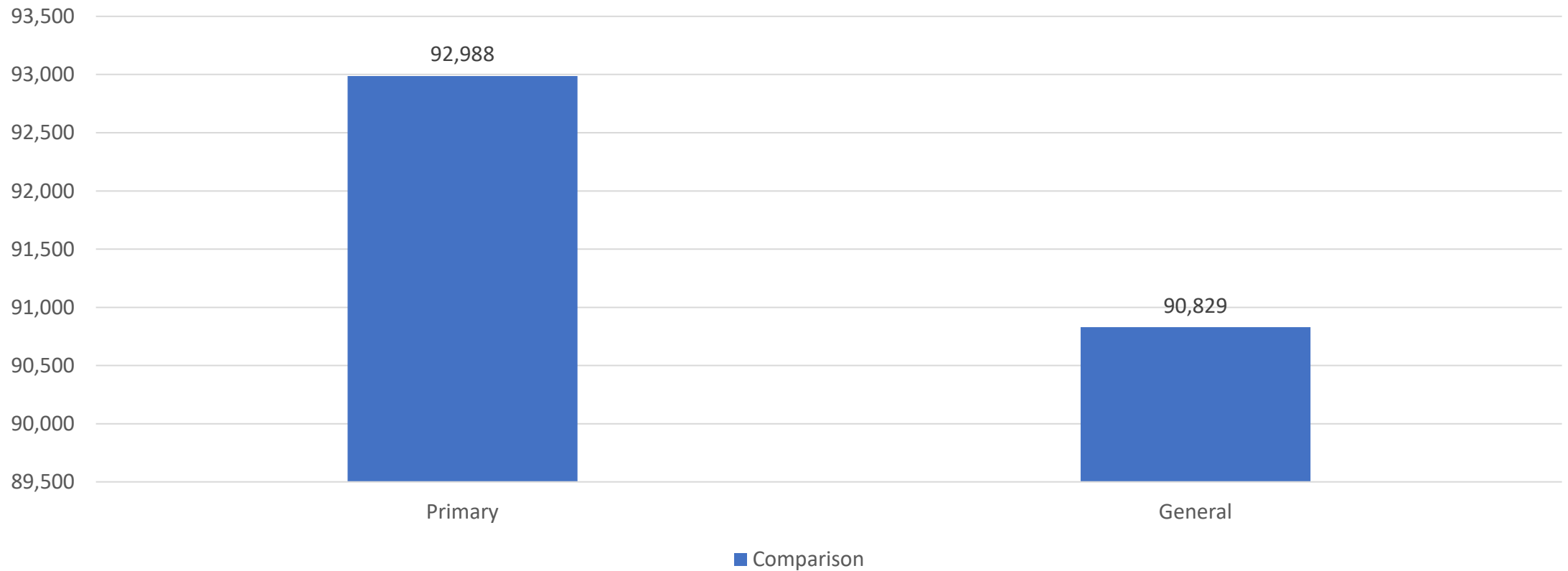


Coconino County, AZ - Political Party Registration

Total Registered = 90,829



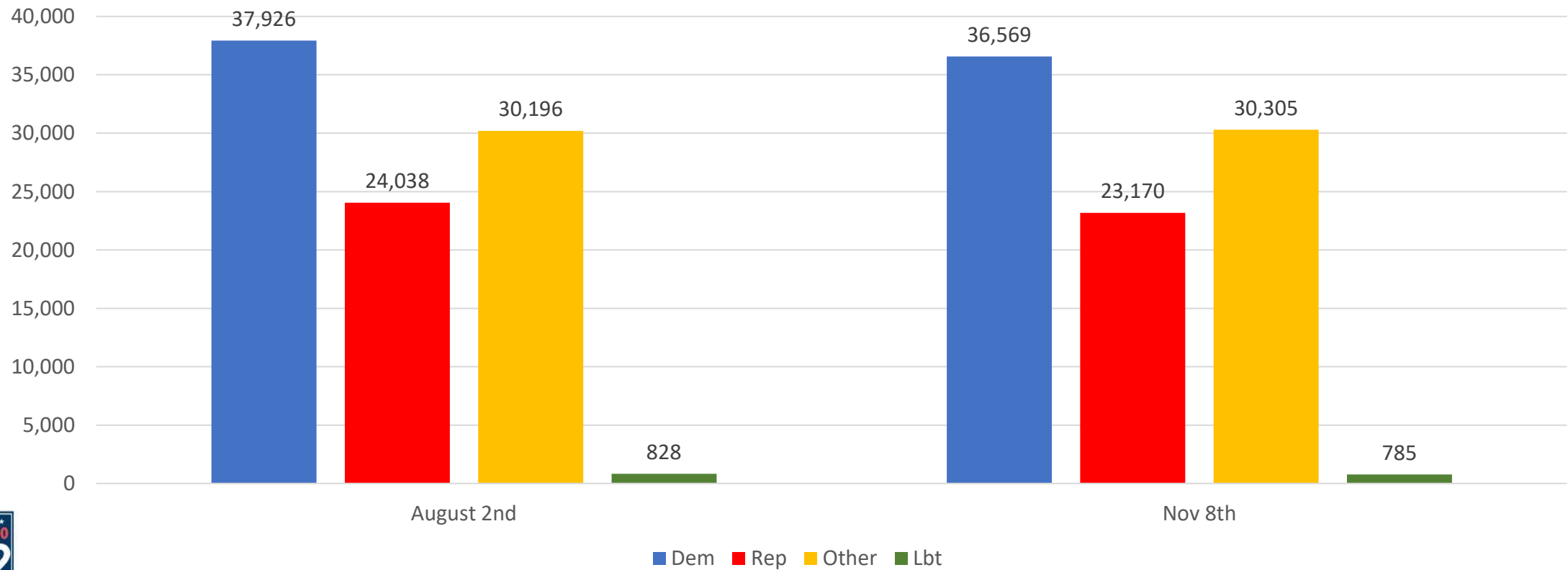
Decline in Registration from Primary of 2,159 Registered Voters

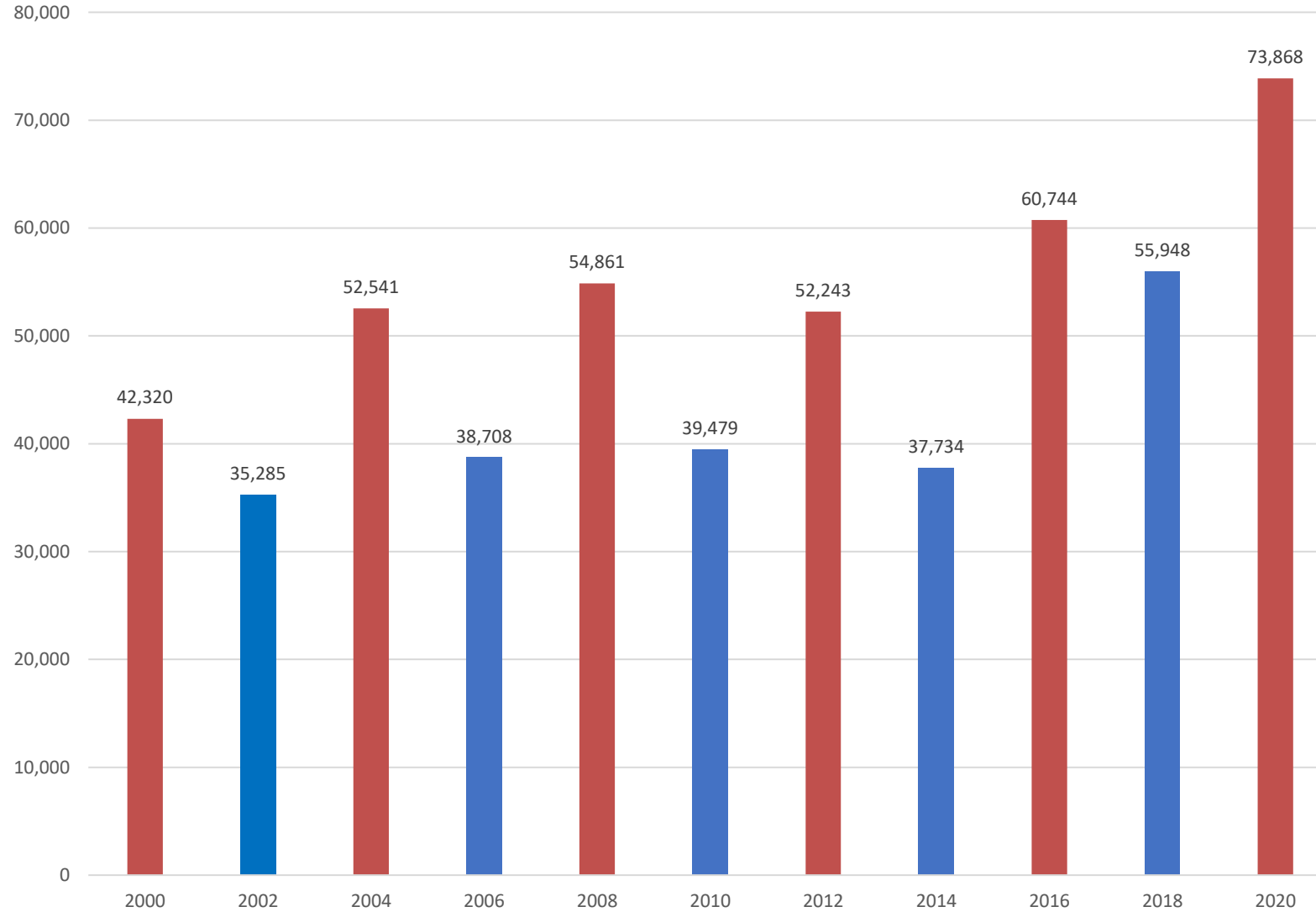
Comparison of Voter Registration August 2nd Primary – November 8th General

Political Party Breakdown

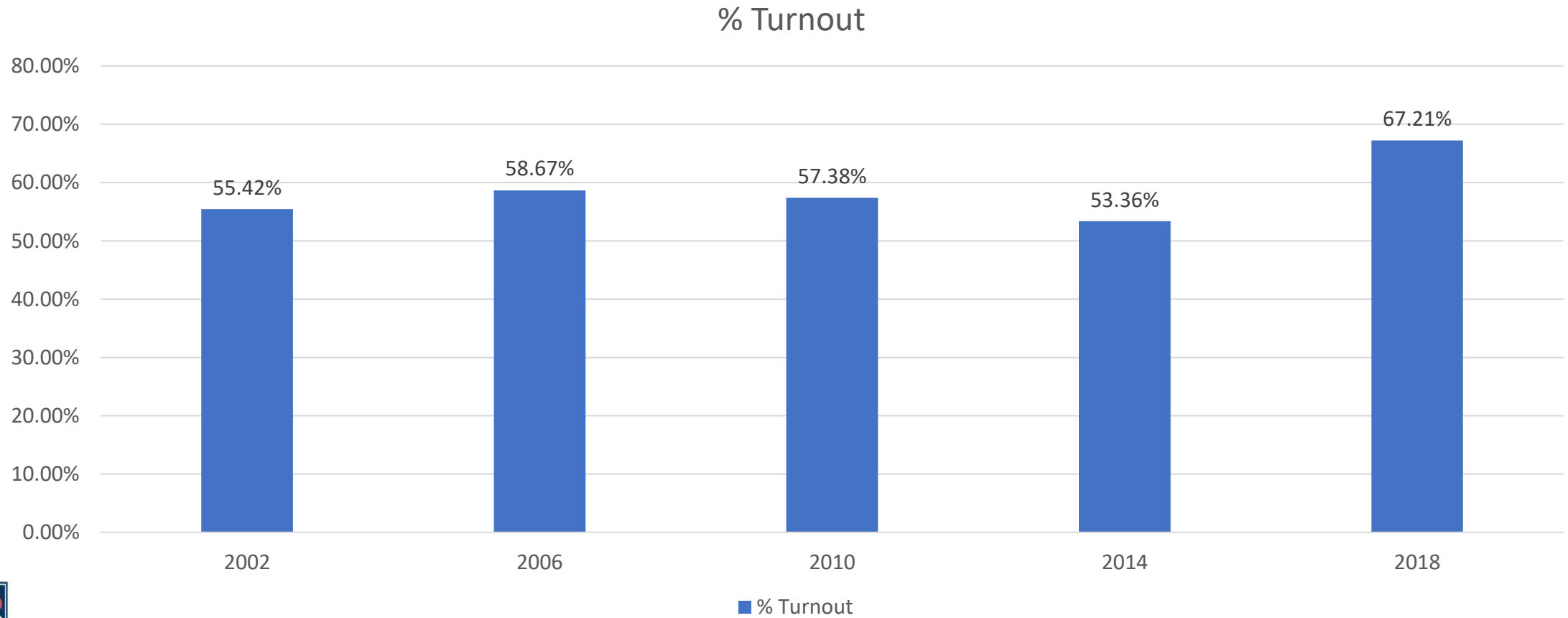


General Elections 2000 to 2020

Important Early Voting Dates

- **Friday, October 28th** @ 5 pm – Last Day to Request An Early Ballot by Mail
- **Tuesday, November 1st** – Recommended latest day to return Early Ballot by USPS mail to ensure it arrives by Election Day
- **Friday, November 4th** @ 5 pm – Last Day to Vote Early In-Person
- **Monday, November 7th** – Emergency Early Voting
- **Tuesday, November 8th** @ 7 pm – Deadline to Return Early Ballot



Number of Early Ballots Issued Through October 24, 2022

- **Total Issued = 65,022**
 - AEVL = 63,780
 - In-Person Voters = 468
 - Single Election Requests = 774



How Early Ballots Are Being Returned Through October 24, 2022

Total Returned = 11,412 (17.55%)

- By USPS Mail = 7,057
- Drop in a Ballot Drop Box = 3,754
- In-Person Early Voting = 435
- Navajo Nation Mobile Sites = 46
- UOCAVA Online System = 88
- UOCAVA Postal Mail = 32

Problems

Unsigned or Mismatched Signatures

- Phone calls
- Text messages – Text2Cure
- E-mails
- Letters

Unsigned have to be corrected by 7 pm on Election Day

**Mismatched signature problems have until 5 business days after election
(November 16, 2022)**
