Discussion Topics

- 1.) **Clearwater-Safe Harbor follow up visit update-** Dr. Marie Peoples gave a brief update of who will be in attendance for the trip and potential goals for the follow up visit. Attending the trip will be a combination of City/County officials and community providers.
- 2.) **Court Facilities Study-** Superior Court Administrator Sharon Yates discussed the facilities study that was recently approved by the Board of Supervisors. The study includes an overall assessment of all County Court facilities and will begin within the next 90 days. Sharon will provide more information and detail at the next CJCC meeting.
- 3.) **The Guidance Center: Services and Programming-** Clinical Supervisor Trever Davis discussed the updated/new services and programming at TGC. Some of the highlights of Mr. Davis's presentation was the availability of voluntary walk-in services at any time, follow up services with a care manager now take place within 7 days, and new inpatient medical teams. TGC has been conducting mental health first aid trainings monthly as well.
- 4.) **Committee Updates-** Each committee member shared information pertaining to their respective office/department. County Attorney Bill Ring provided an in-depth legislative update about Rep. Blackman's proposed pre-arrest diversion bill. Committee members shared their thoughts on specific paragraphs of the bill and potential changes that could be made for the benefit of all jurisdictions.
