General Information

Election Worker Qualifications

- Be a registered voter in Coconino County
- Be able to read and write English
- Attend an election worker training for every election
- Remain at the polling place on Election Day for the entire day, usual hours are from 5:30 a.m. until polls close between 8 PM - 9 PM

Election Worker Compensation

Election Workers are paid:

- \$90 for Election Day
- \$20 for training
- \$10 for Pre-Election Set Up Meeting
- Please Note: Election Board Workers who do not work on Election Day do not receive compensation for attending training/pre-election meeting

Election Workers are vital to efficient and honest elections. They conduct elections with accuracy, integrity and dignity

What does an Election Worker do?

- Open and close the polling place
- Set up voting equipment
- Assist voter in locating correct polling place to cast their ballot
- Sign in voters
- Distribute ballots
- Record and verify vote totals
- Maintain the integrity of elections at the polling place



Why be an Election Worker?

Coconino County Election Workers serve the public by:

- Ensuring fair and efficient voting processes at the polls
- Allowing voters to cast their ballots privately and independently
- On Election Day, Coconino County hires over 400 election workers to work at polling places through out Coconino County
