Administrative Order No. 2017-09 of the Superior Court in Coconino County established a countywide Security and Emergency Preparedness Committee (SEPC) consisting of a representative cross-section of each local SEPC in the County with each local court within the county being represented on the committee.

Outlined in the Court Security Standards adopted by Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2017-15 the Courts must have a security manual addressing the basic tenets of court safety and security.

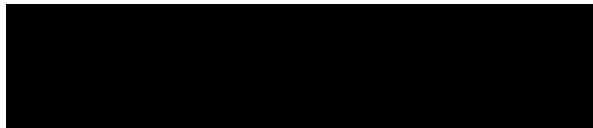
WHEREAS; The Countywide SEPC has developed and disseminated a security manual template to all Coconino County Courts,

WHEREAS; The Countywide SEPC has approved and is recommending the County security manual template to be used by all Coconino County Courts,

THEREFORE; pursuant to the Court Security Standards adopted by Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2017-15 requiring all courts to have a security manual and based upon the recommendation of the countywide SEPC,

IT IS ORDERED; that the "Court Security Manual: Courts of Coconino County" be adopted as the security manual for all courts in Coconino County. Each court shall add additional security related information unique to the needs and security plans of the court.
