#### Bulk Waste



- Load sizes are limited: 1 Voucher = 1 trip up to 3 cubic yards (A standard pickup bed is 2' x 8' long x 5' wide) or 1 ton for bulk waste
- **Large loads may be weighed**
- Residents **WILL** be charged for entire loads that are oversized
- Waste tires accepted **WITHOUT RIMS**

#### Green Waste



- No load size restrictions
- All green waste is accepted
- Green waste includes pine needles, branches and clean construction lumber

### THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED:

- ✗ Loose Trash
- ✗ Vehicle Parts
- ✗ Unevacuated Refrigerators, Air Conditioners, or Any Other Item Containing Refrigerants
- ✗ Waste Tires **WITH** Rims
- ✗ Dead Animals
- ✗ Hazardous or Bio-Waste
- ✗ Dirt, Rocks, Concrete

#### Hazardous Materials Which Include:

- ✗ Antifreeze, Batteries, Electronic Waste, Fluorescent Bulbs, Oils, Paints, Pesticides, Refrigerants, & Solvents

Please take all Hazardous Materials to the **Flagstaff Hazardous Products Center (HPC)** located on 6770 East Landfill Road. For more information please contact (928) 213-2159. **HPC IS FREE TO ALL COUNTY RESIDENTS!**
