ONLY Green Waste is FREE at Willard Springs Transfer Station During Cleanup Days

- No Voucher Required
- No Load Size Restrictions
- No Trip Limit

What Green Waste is/is not accepted at Willard Springs Transfer Station?

- **ACCEPTED:** ONLY Natural Forest Material Like Pine Needles
- **NOT ACCEPTED:** Tree stumps
- **NOT ACCEPTED:** Trees more than 6 feet long or 6 inches in diameter are not accepted at Willard Springs

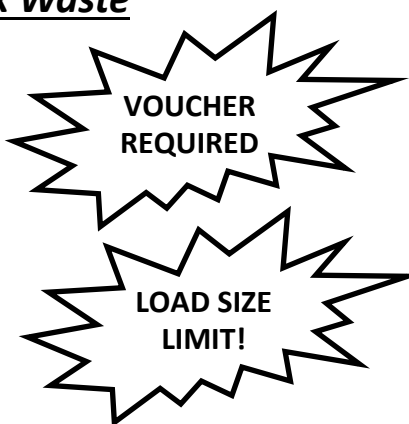

Bulk Waste

- Load sizes are limited: 1 Voucher = 1 trip up to 3 cubic yards (A standard pickup bed is 2' x 8' long x 5' wide) or 1 ton for bulk waste **OR** 1 refrigerated appliance
- **Large loads may be weighed**
- Residents **WILL** be charged for entire loads that are oversized



Yard Waste

- Yard waste such as pine needles, grass clippings & leaves cannot be processed like green waste
- **USE YOUR YARD WASTE VOUCHER** to deposit one load of yard waste (any size)



Green Waste

- Green waste such as branches and stumps are always free at the Landfill!

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED:

- ✗ Loose Trash
- ✗ Waste Tires
- ✗ Dirt, Rocks, Concrete
- ✗ Vehicle Parts
- ✗ Dead Animals
- ✗ Bio-Waste

Hazardous Waste Materials

NO VOUCHER IS NECESSARY FOR HAZARDOUS WASTE MATERIALS, which include Antifreeze, Batteries, Electronic Waste, Fluorescent Bulbs, Oils, Paints, Pesticides & Solvents.

Please take all Hazardous Waste Materials to the **Flagstaff Hazardous Products Center (HPC)** located on 6770 East Landfill Road. The HPC is open 8:00am to 3:00pm Monday – Saturday. For more information please contact (928) 213-2159. **HPC IS FREE TO ALL COUNTY RESIDENTS!**
