**Sample Ballots Have Been Mailed for November 6 General Election**

**Flagstaff, Az.** – Sample ballots for the upcoming November 6 General Election have been mailed to households with registered voters who have not been issued early ballots. The sample ballot contains the voters’ polling place information.

There are several ballot questions on the General Election ballot so we encourage voters to use their sample ballots and informational pamphlets to be prepared to vote prior to going to their polling place on Election Day. Voters are allowed to bring a sample ballot with them to the polling place to use as a guide when they vote.

Voters that have limited time to go to their polling place on Election Day may want to vote early in person prior to Election Day to avoid having to wait in line to vote. The County Election offices located in downtown Flagstaff, 110 E Cherry Ave; at the Flagstaff Mall (next to JCPenney); and in Tuba City will be open this Saturday, October 27<sup>th</sup> from 10:00 am to 5:00 pm (local time) for in-person early voting.

The deadline to vote early in person is Friday, November 2 at 5:00 pm.
