# COCONINO COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

*“A Living Plan” Annual and 10-Year Cycle*

**VISION.** *The Comprehensive Plan represents a **20-year vision for the County** which is updated every 10 years through a public process and adoption by the Board of Supervisors.*

**IMPLEMENT.** *Annually, once the Board of Supervisors sets the County priorities and budget, County departments, entities, and agencies **select goals, policies, and action items** from the Comprehensive Plan to work towards **implementing** over the coming year. This work may include updating documents such as Area Plans and the Zoning Ordinance, creating partnerships and carrying out projects, while measuring progress. An **Annual Implementation Summary Report** is assembled and presented to the Board of Supervisors each spring to aid in budgeting discussions, and the annual cycle begins again.*

**UPDATE.** *Every 10 years, the Comprehensive Plan is evaluated to see if the **vision** has been met, and what work is left to be done. It then undergoes an update process through **public meetings** to discern **new goals, policies, and action items**, resulting in a newly updated and adopted Comprehensive Plan. The annual cycle for the updated Comprehensive Plan now begins, and continues until another Comprehensive Plan update is needed in roughly 10 years.*

**FORMULA**

**Annual:** GOALS, POLICIES, ACTION ITEMS + IMPLEMENTATION + REPORTING = COMP PLAN VISION REALIZED

**10-Year:** REMAINING WORK + PUBLIC INPUT + UPDATING & ADOPTION = NEW GOALS, POLICIES, ACTION ITEMS
