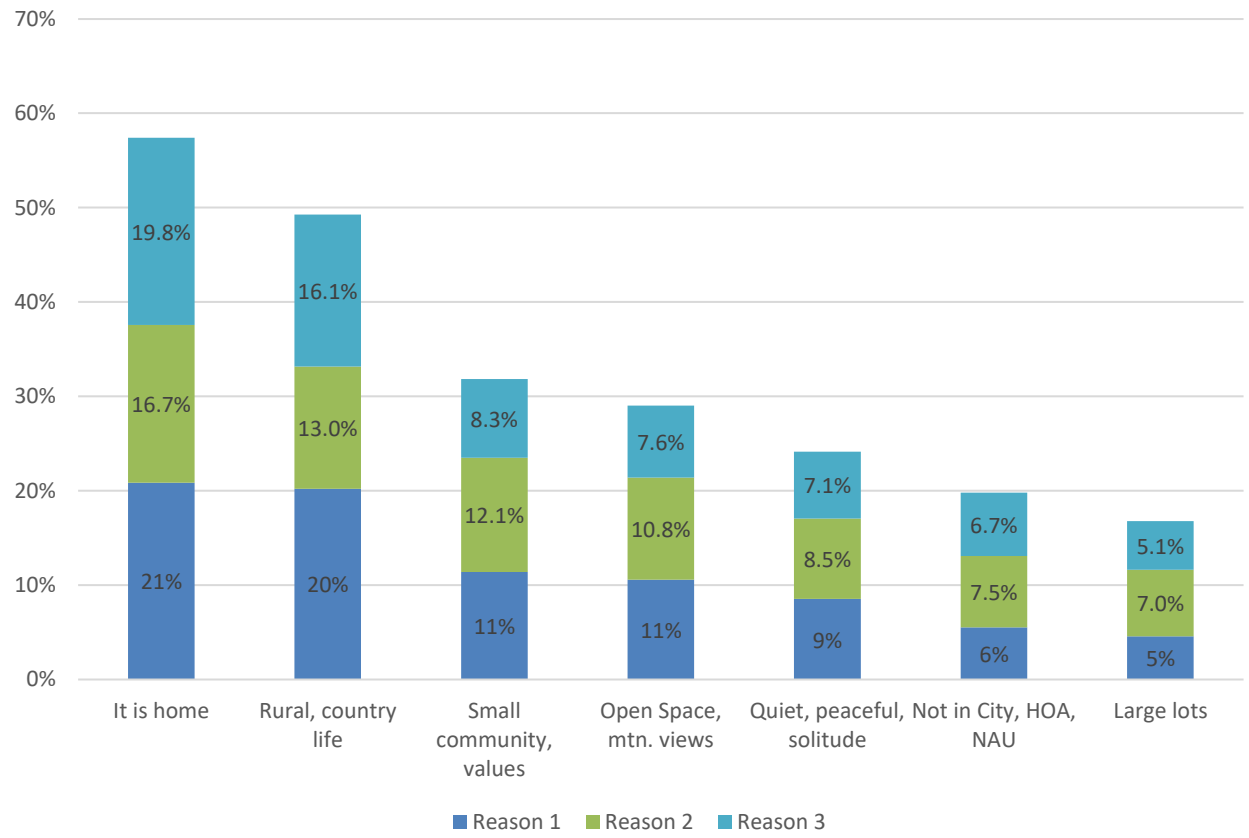

Q1. List three reasons why the Doney Park Timberline Fernwood Community is important to you. Responses = 636

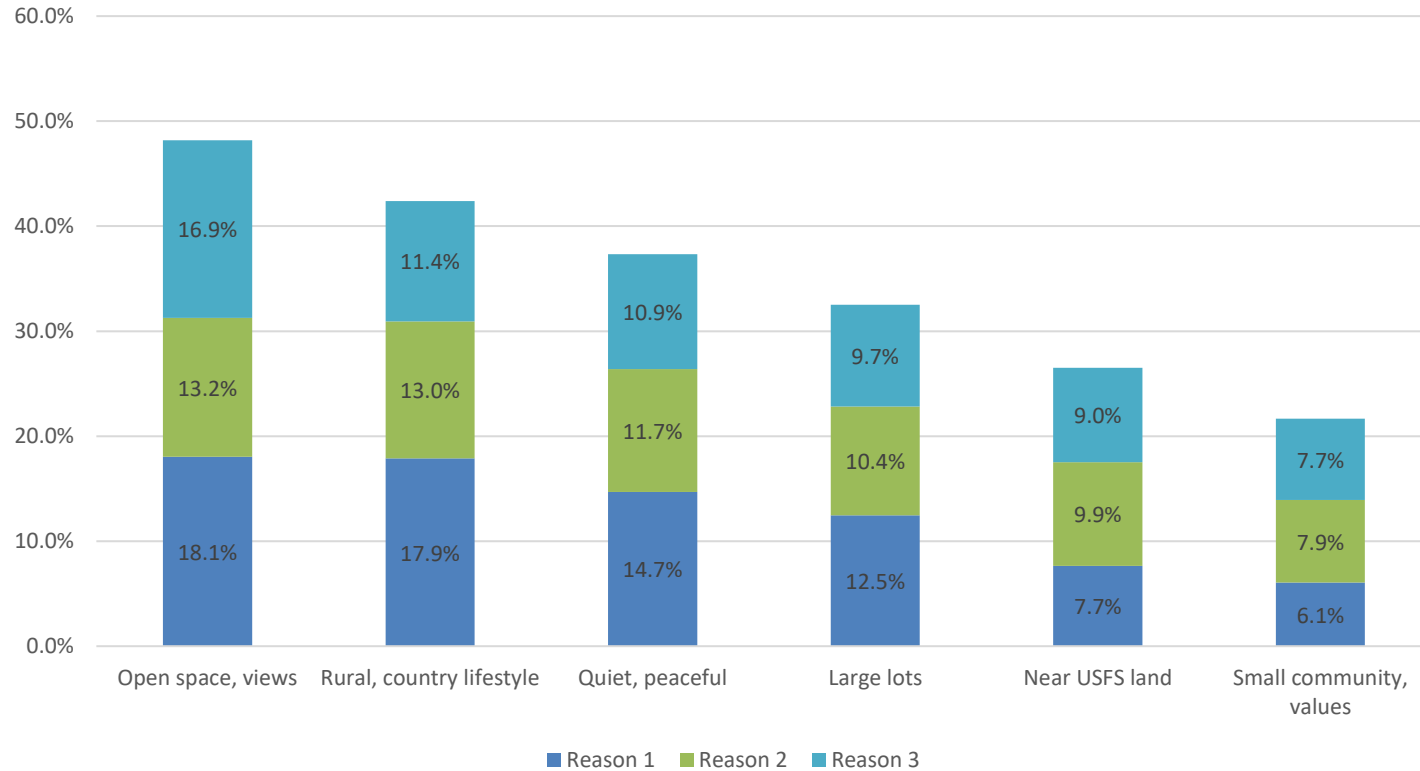
It is home = the school, 2nd residence, have been land stewards for multiple generations, work here, raising a family, retirement home, I love it, long time residents

Large lots = the land; open space between homes, room for outbuildings, zoning for large acreage, land, room to roam, neighbors not too close but close enough

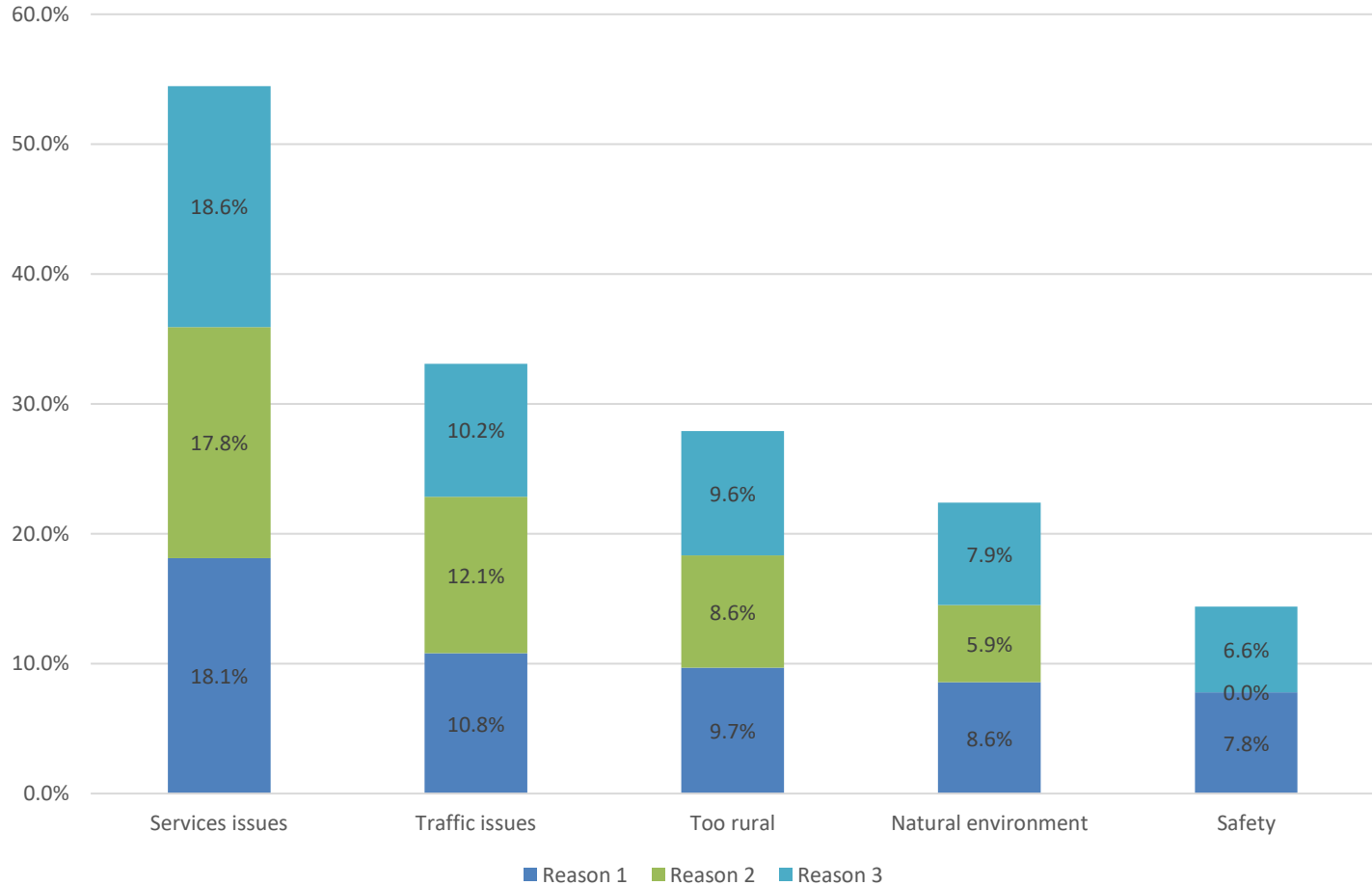
Quiet, peaceful = also means no traffic noise

Safety – emergency response times, fire, flooding, loose dogs

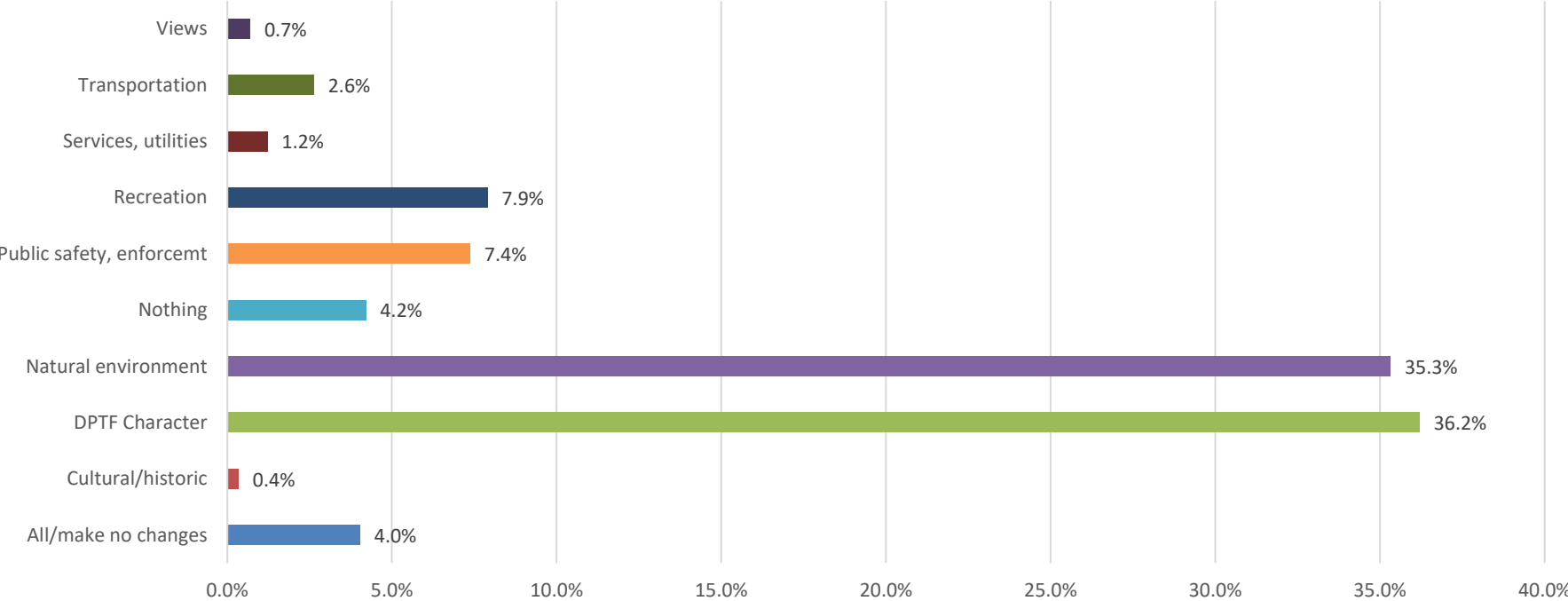
Sense of community – I hate my neighbors

Traffic – speeders

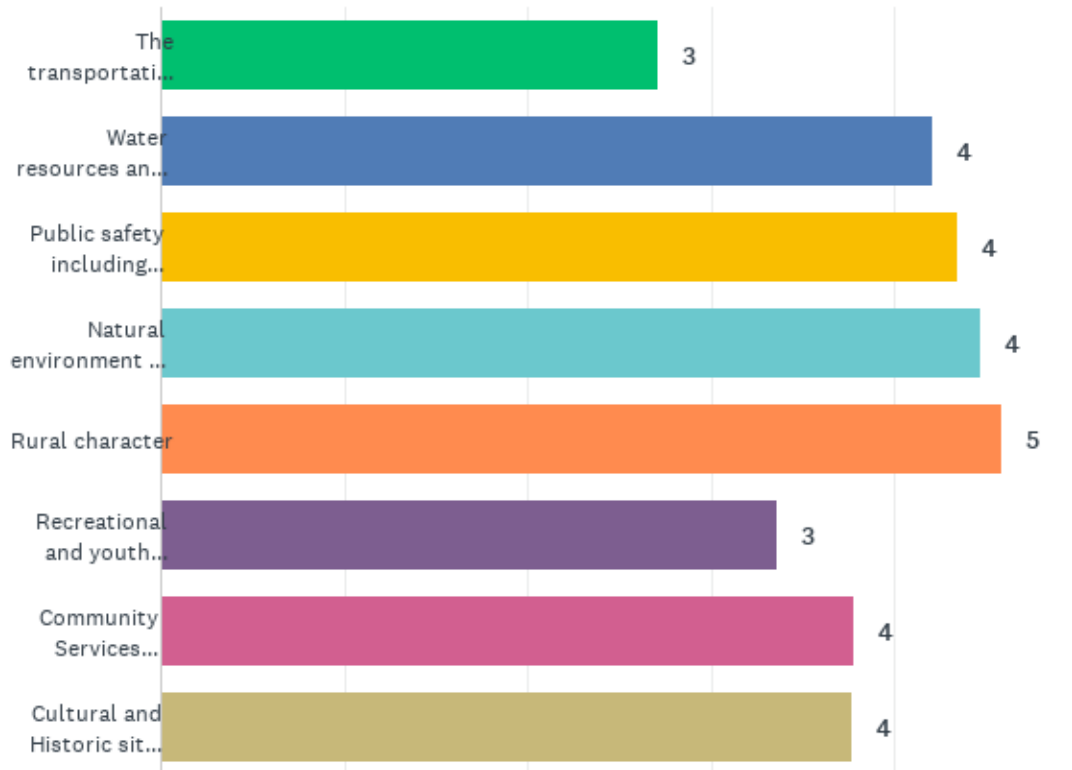

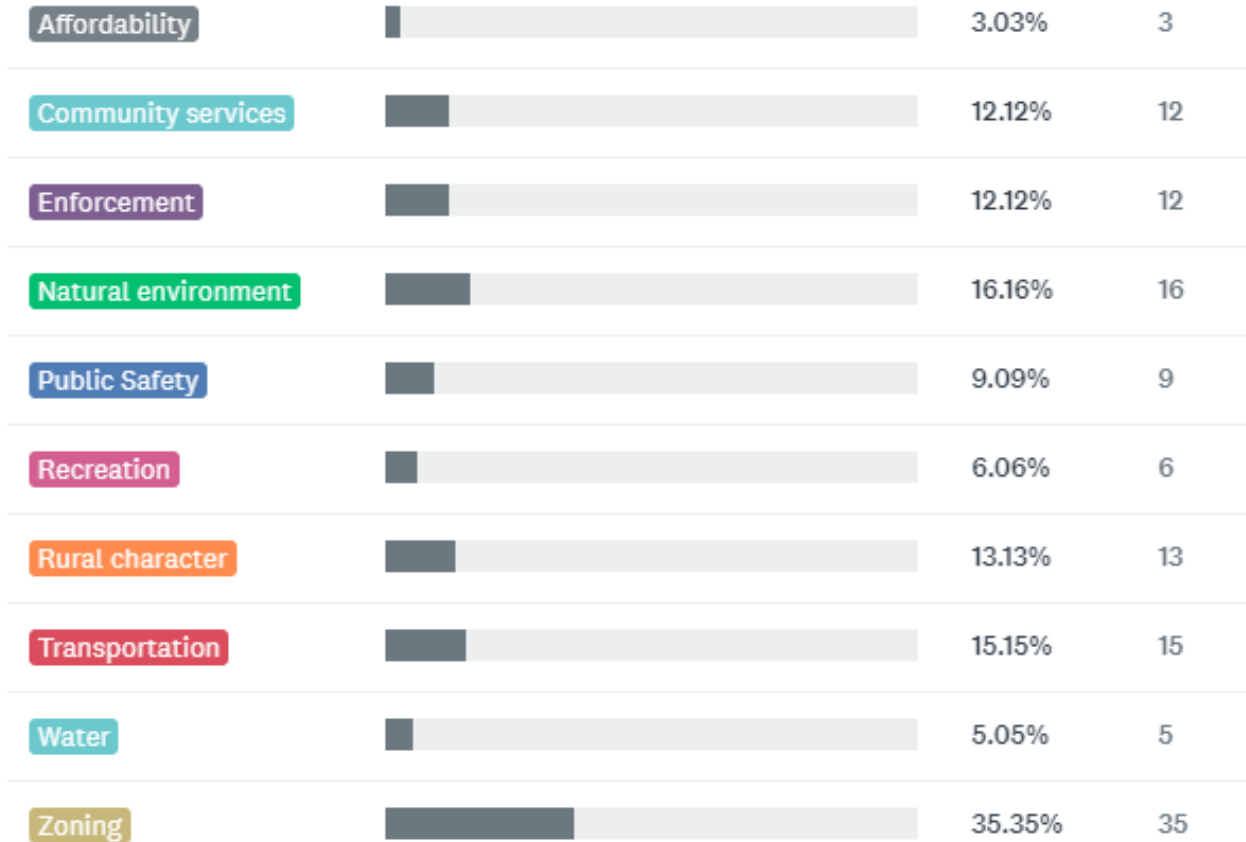

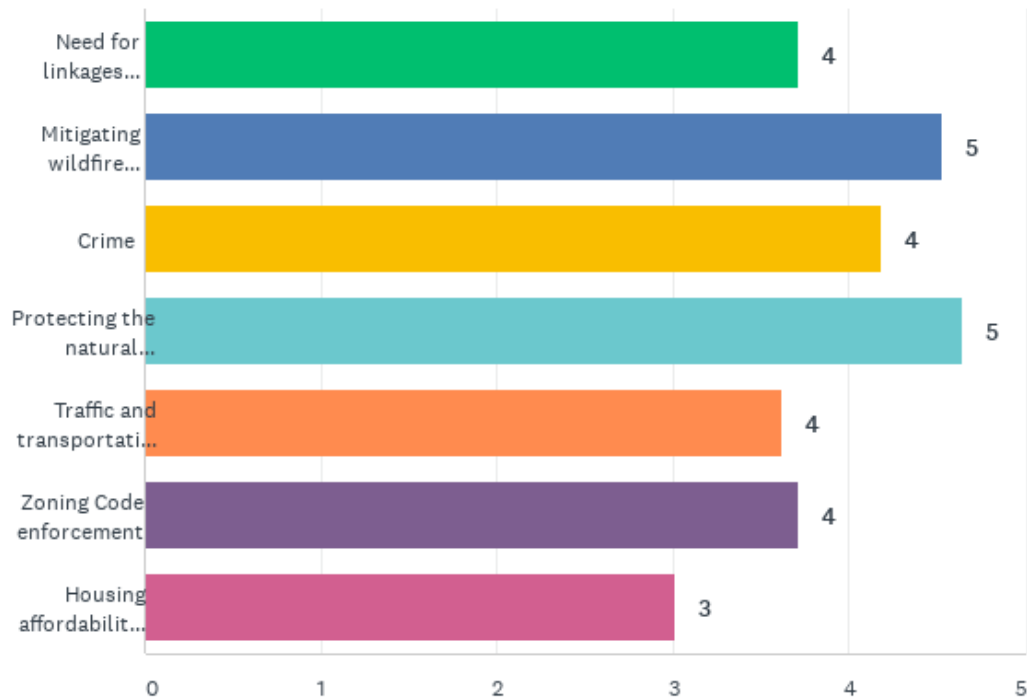
Q 16 – How important are the following topics to quality of life. Other = 98 responses



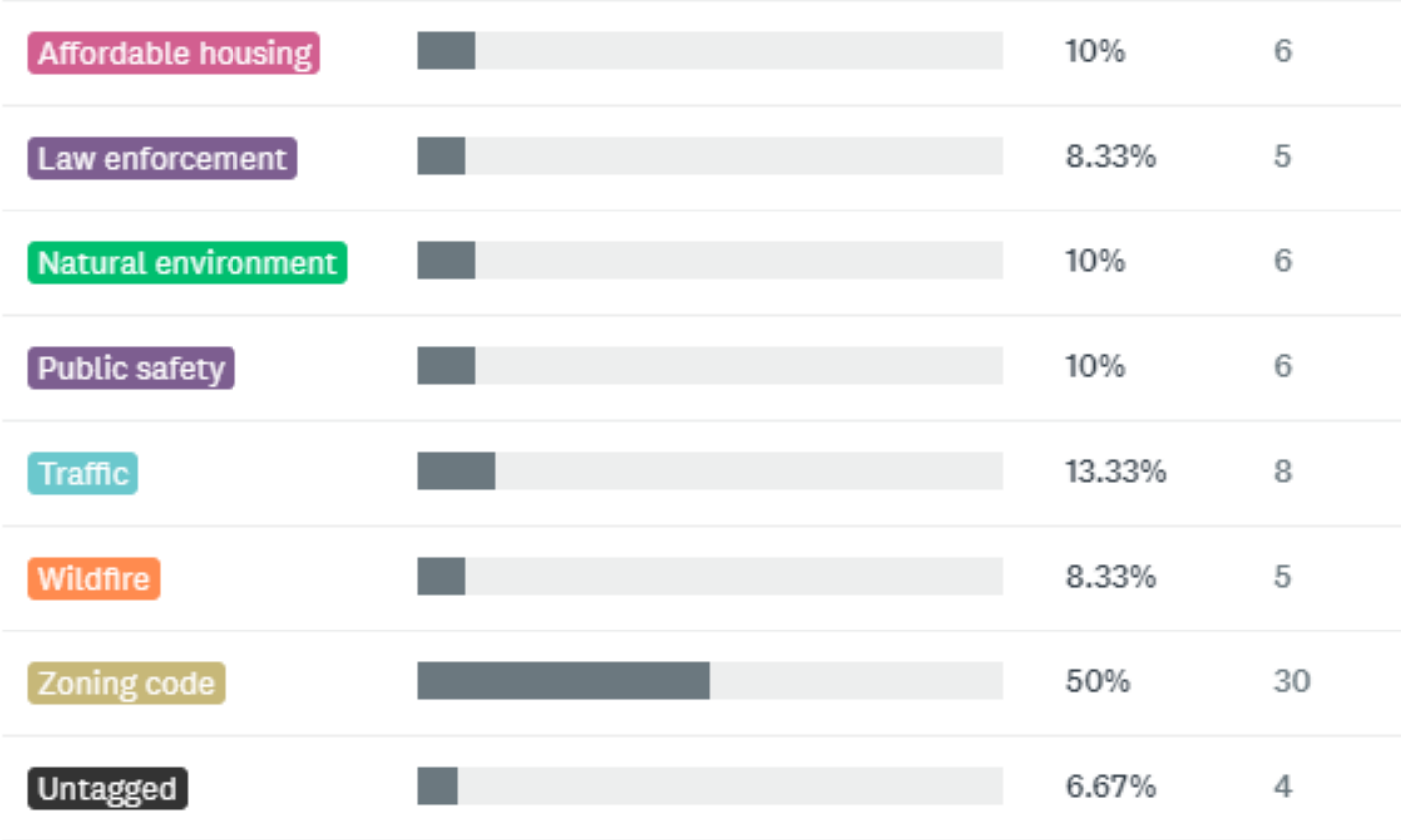
Q17 On a scale of 1 (not important) to 5 (extremely important), how important do you feel the following issues are to the quality of life in DPTF?

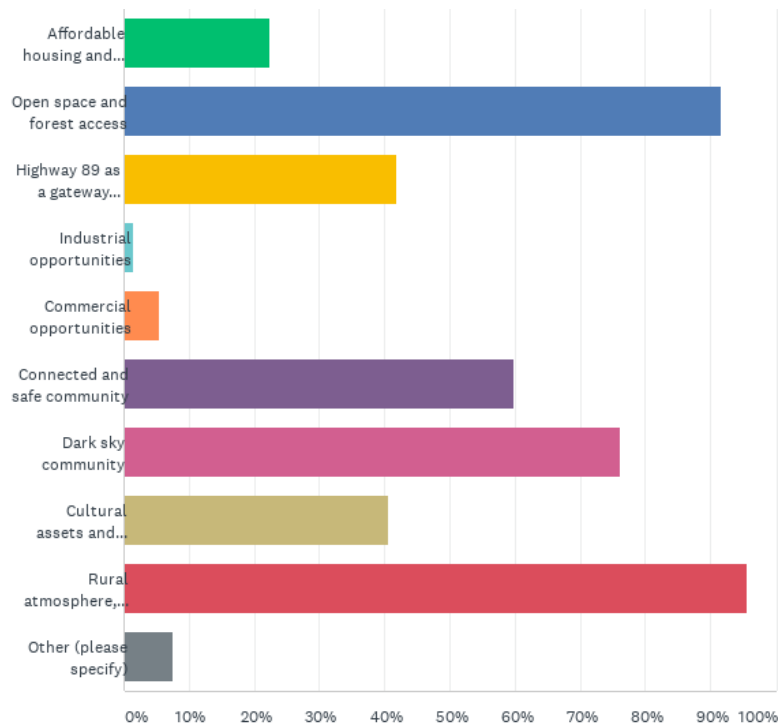


Q17 – How important do you feel the following issues are to the quality of life in DPTF? Other responses = 60

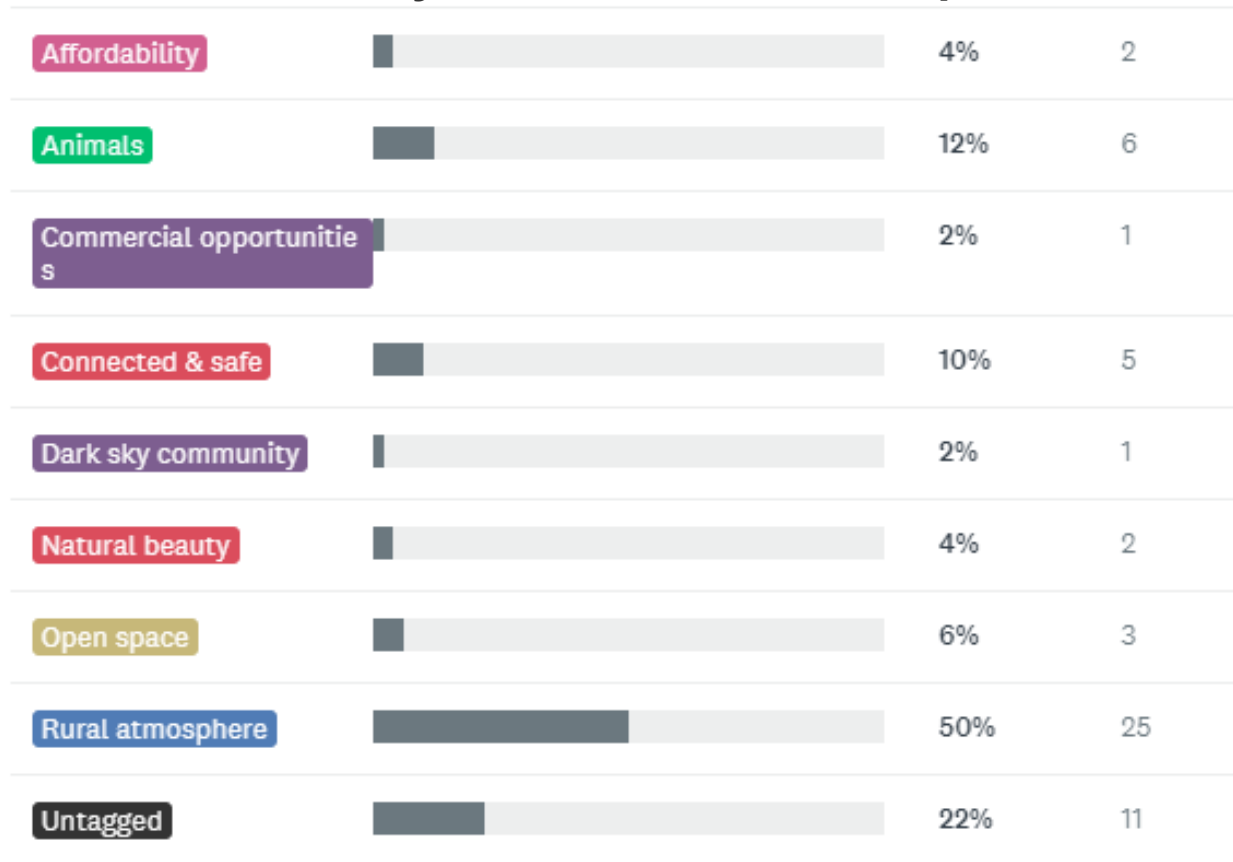


Q18: Which, if any of the following, do you identify with the following as describing DPTF's community character? Please check all that apply.

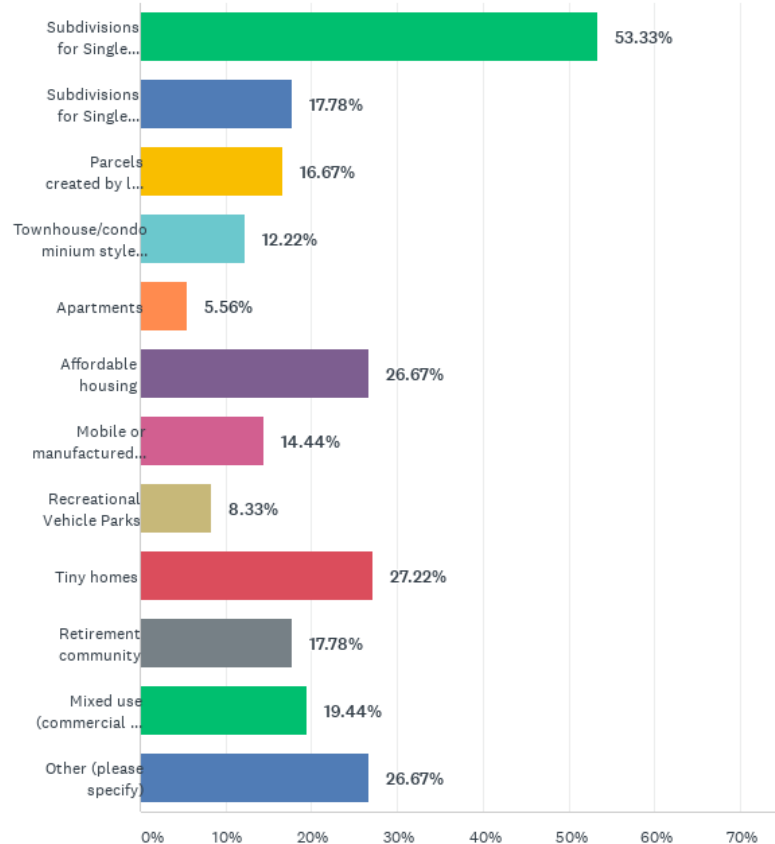
Q18: Which, if any of the following, do you identify with the following as describing DPTF's community character? Other responses = 50



Q22 If you answered YES to question 21, what type of residential development would you like to see in DPTF (check all that apply)?

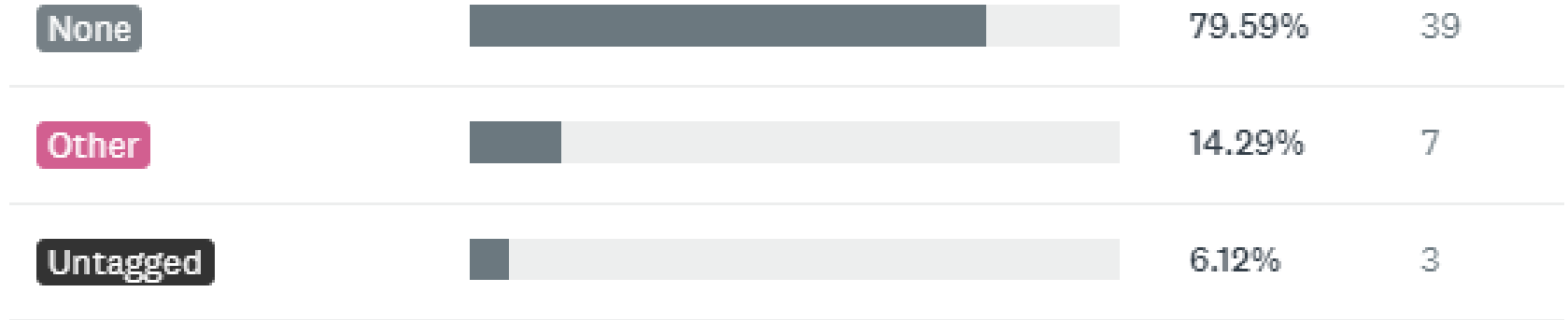

Q22 – What type of residential development would you like to see in DPTF?

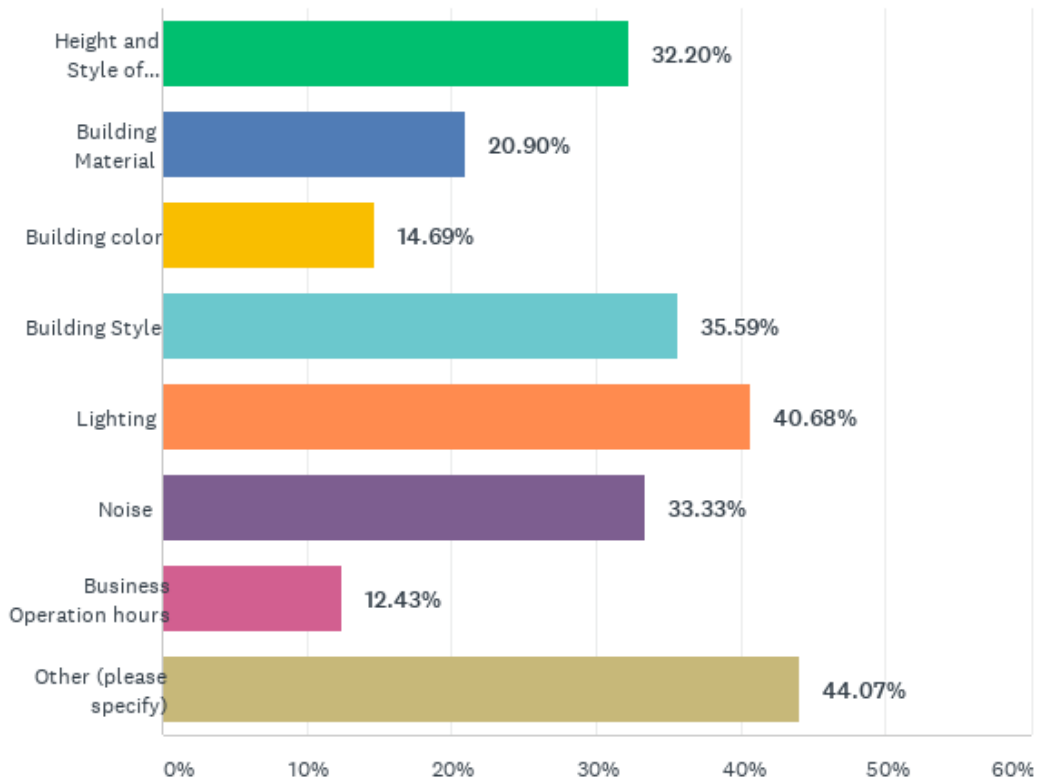

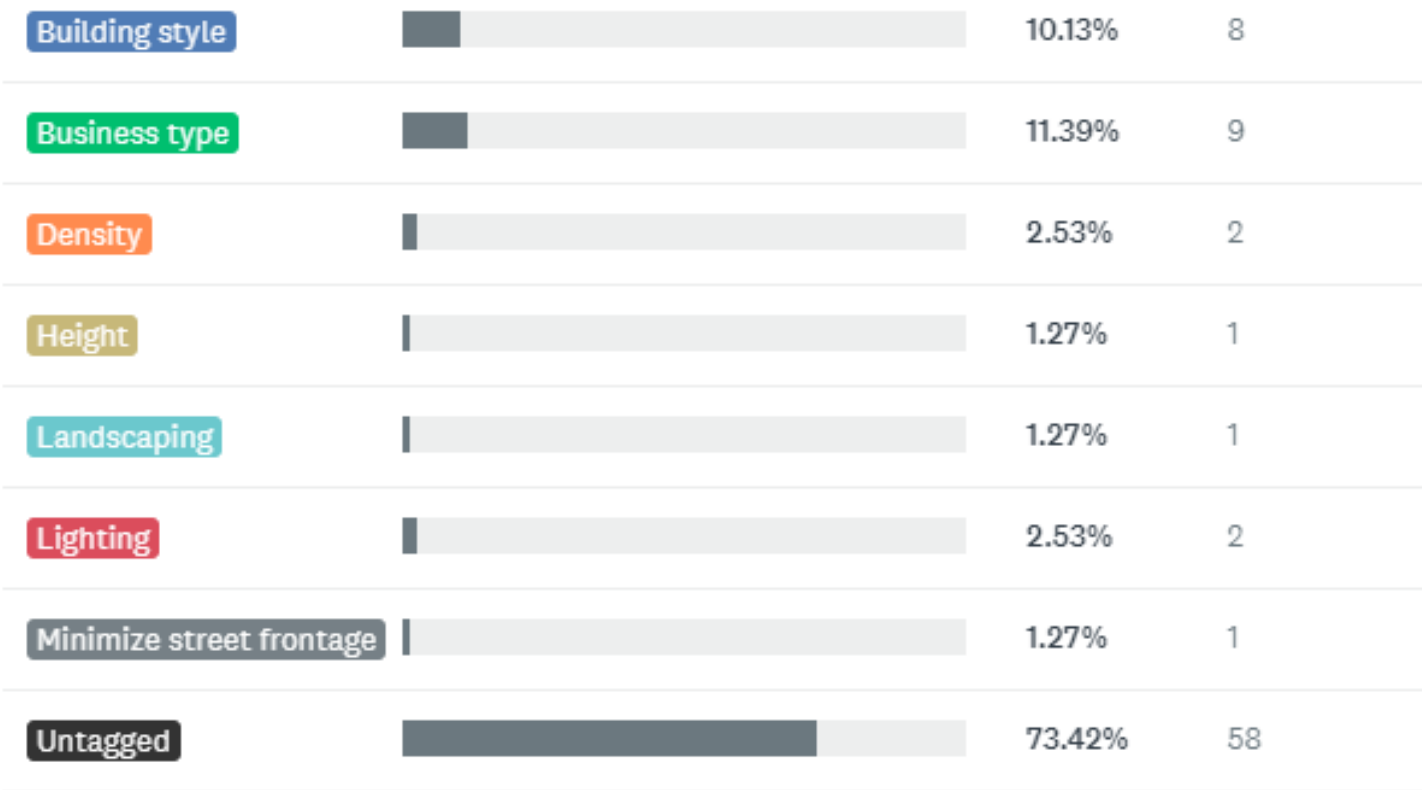
Q24 If you answered NO to question 23, what do you think needs to be changed? Select all that apply.

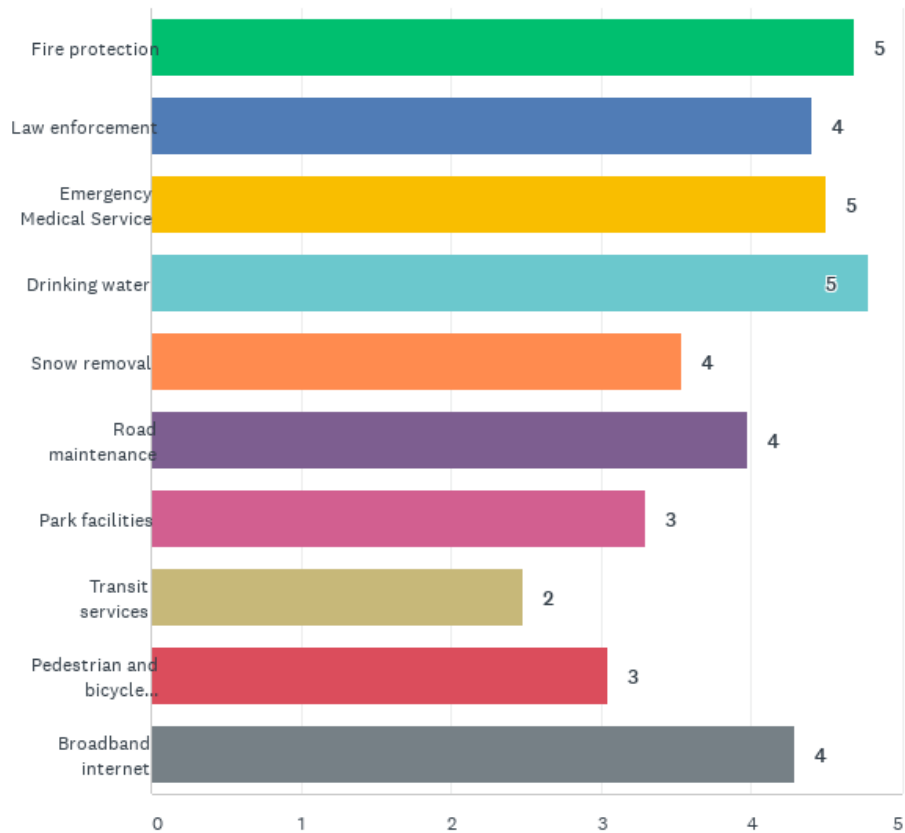
Q24: If you answered NO to question 23 (does the DRO reflect desired community character and look?), what do you think needs to be changed? Other responses = 79



Q25 On a scale of 1 (not important) to 5 (extremely important), how important are the following public services and facilities to you?

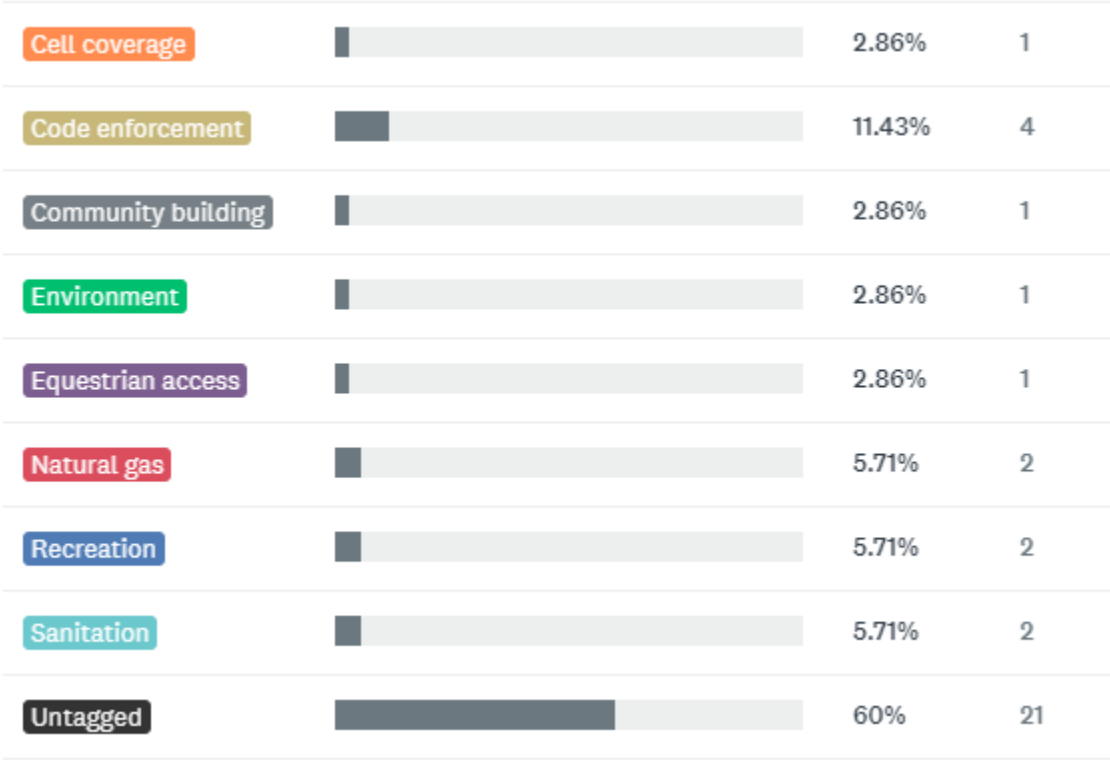

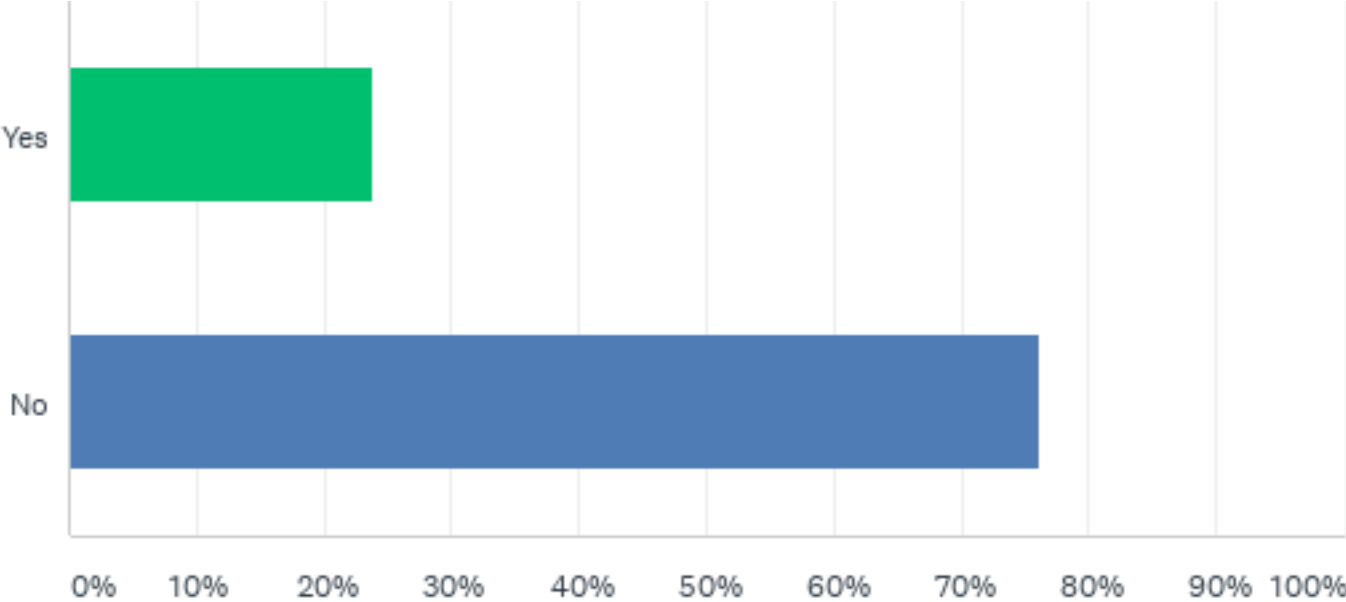
Q25 – How important are the following public services and facilities to you?

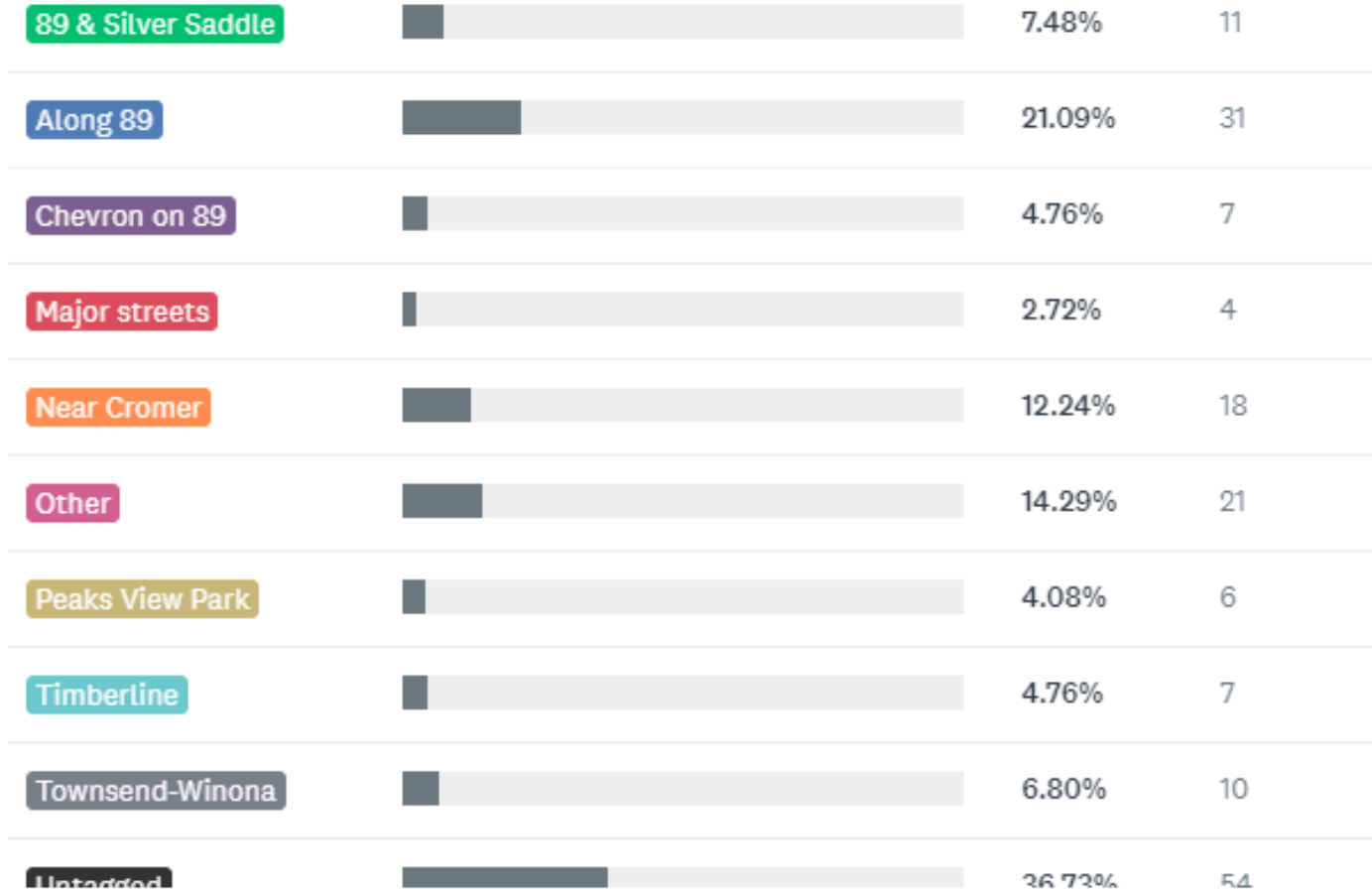


Q29: Do you think additional Rural Activity Centers (commercial and public service centers) are needed in DPTF?

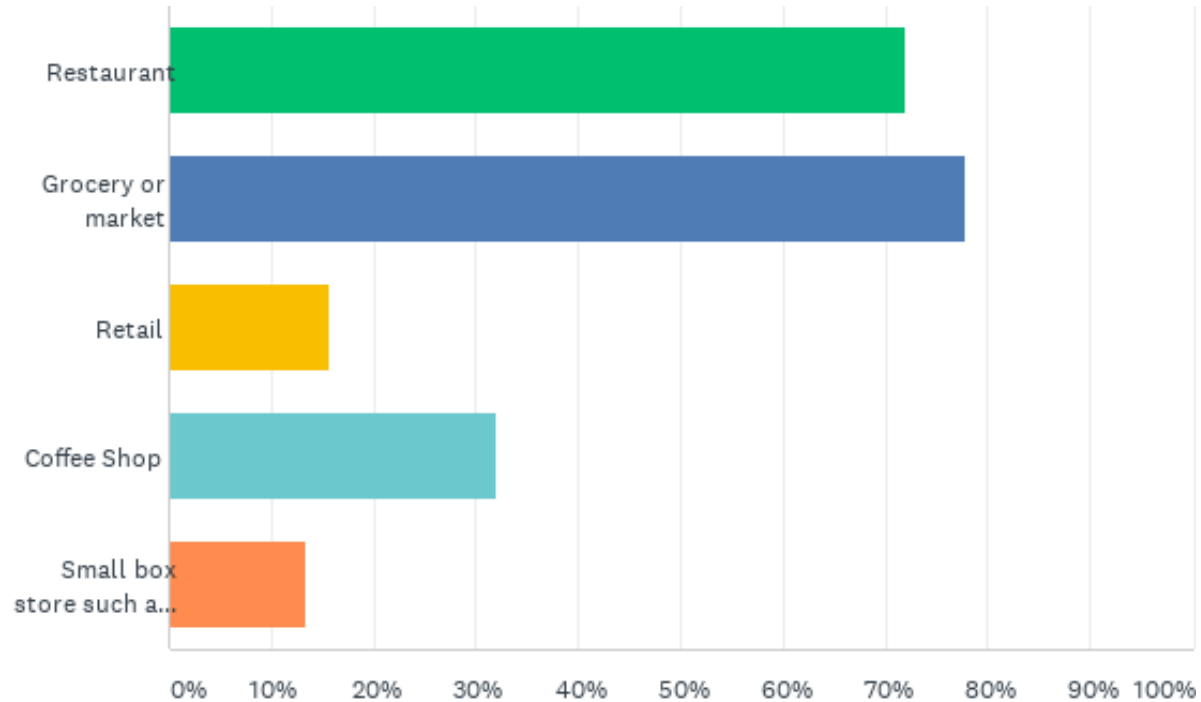


Q30: If you answered yes to Q29, where should additional Rural Activity Centers be located? Responses = 147

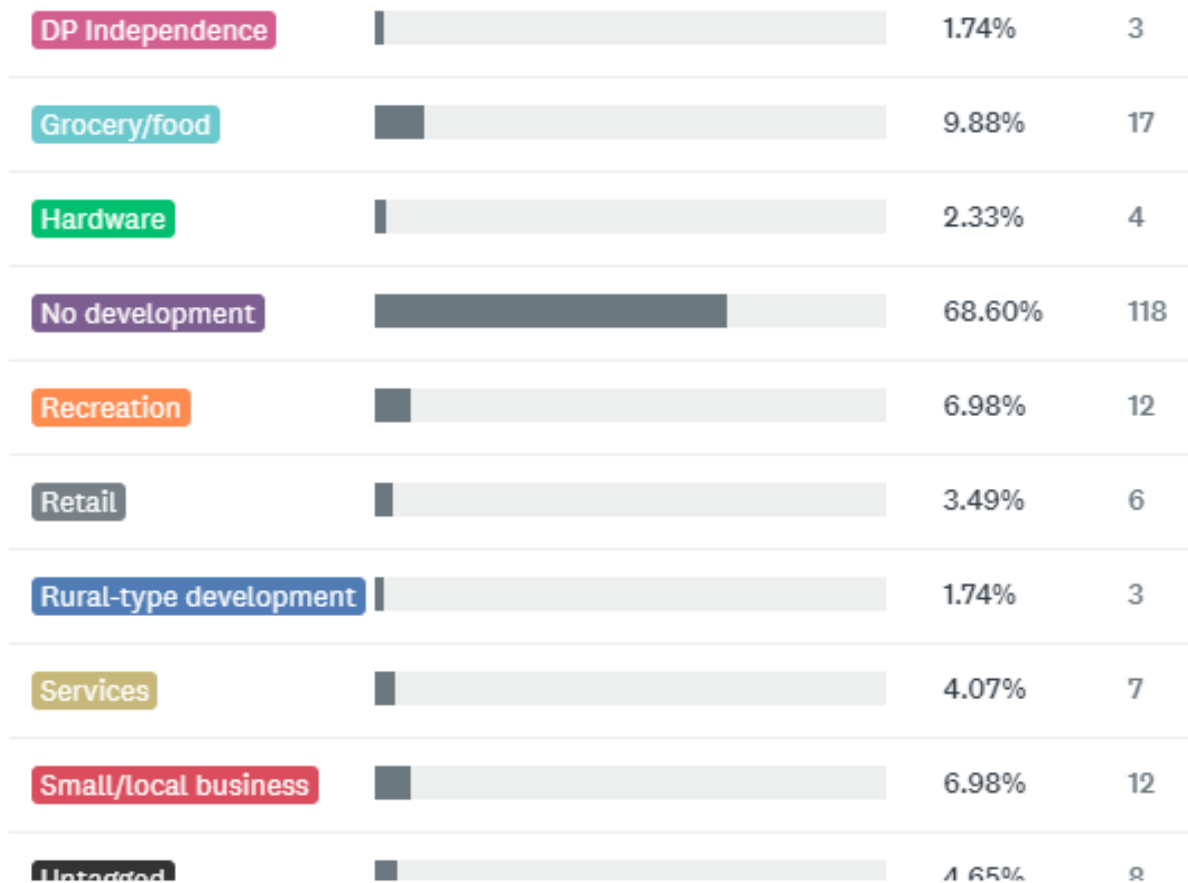


Q32: What type of neighborhood-serving commercial development would you like to see in DPTF? Check all that apply.

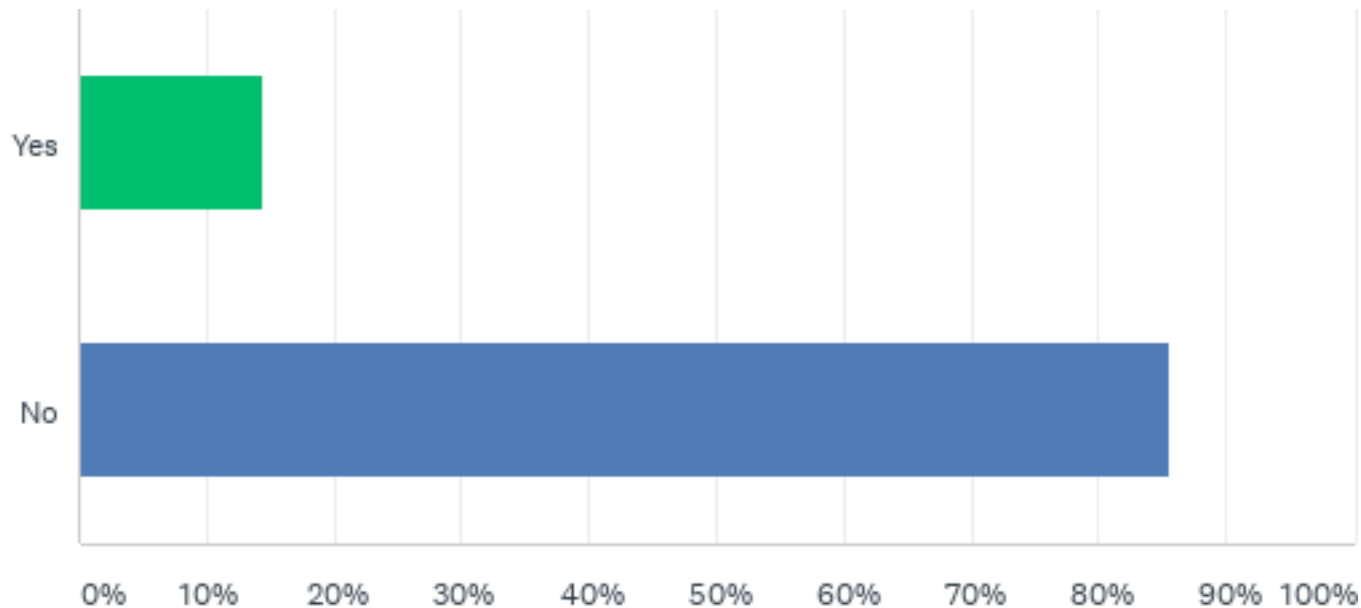


Q32: What type of neighborhood-serving commercial development would you like to see in DPTF? Other responses = 172

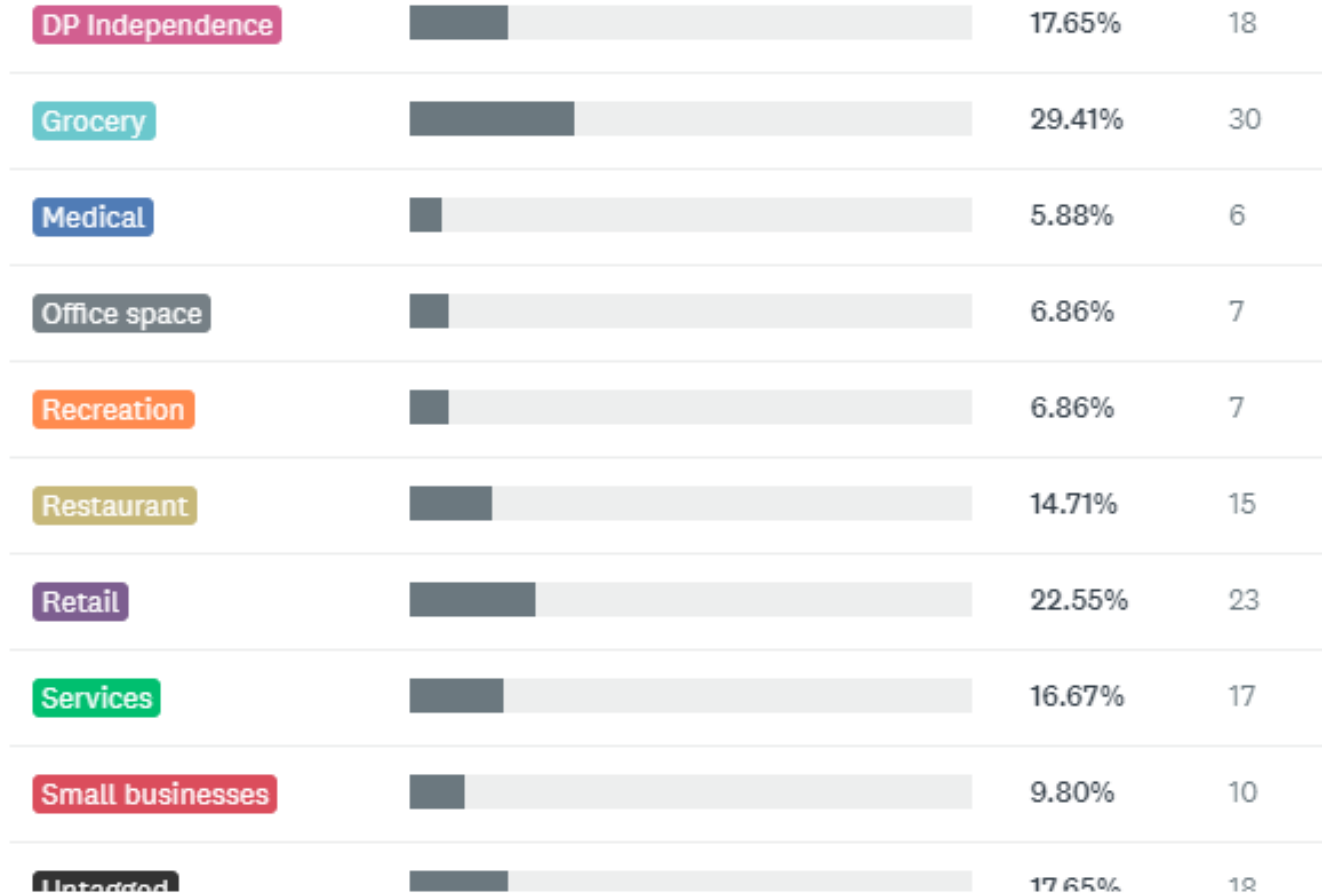


Q33: Do you feel there is a need for additional commercially zoned property in DPTF, for uses such as retail, offices, and services, in DPTF?

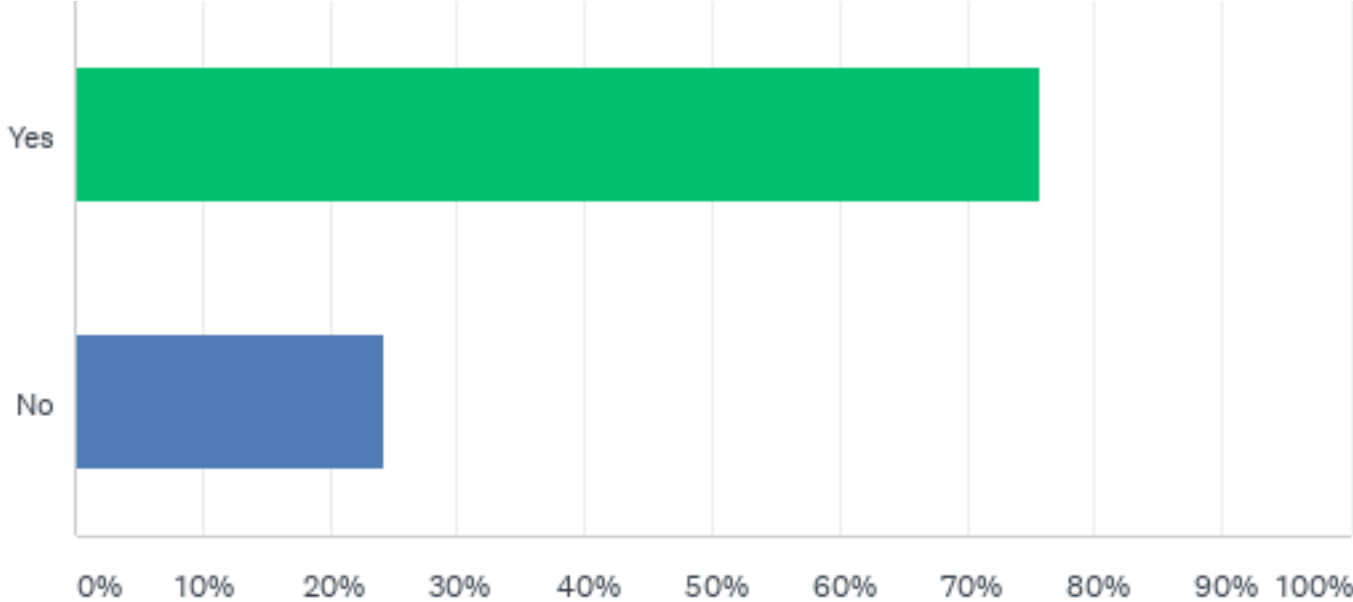


Q34: If you answered YES to question 33, for what purpose? Responses = 102

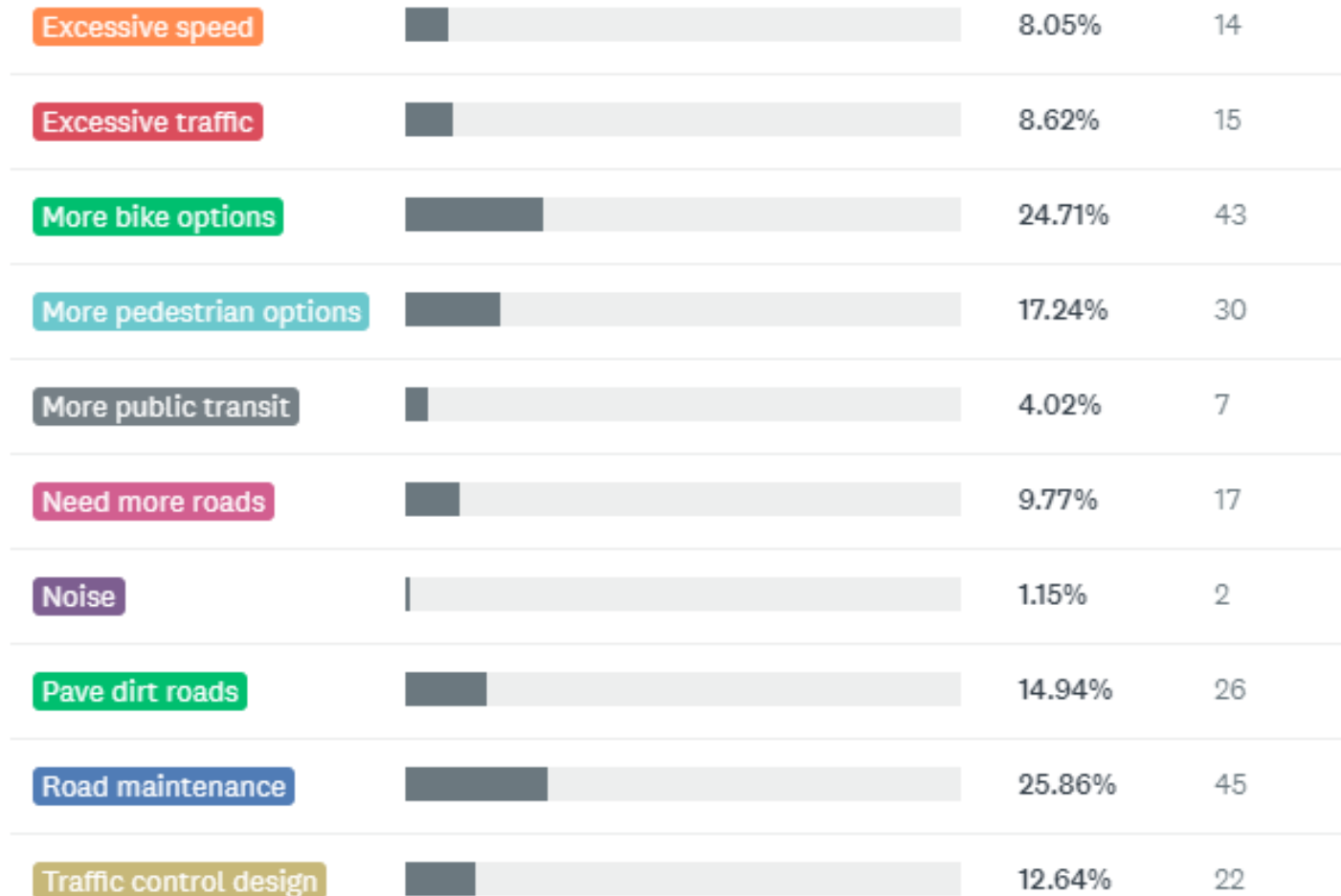


Q36: Does the existing public roadway system in DPTF meet your needs?

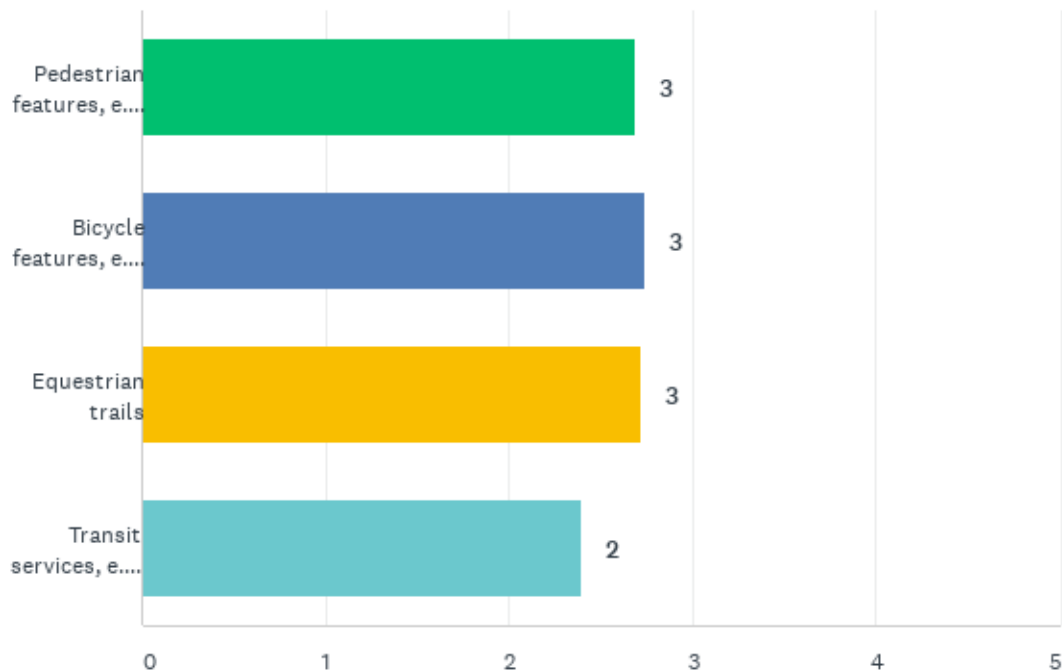

Q40 On a scale of 1 (not important) to 5 (extremely important), how important are the following transportation-related features and amenities?

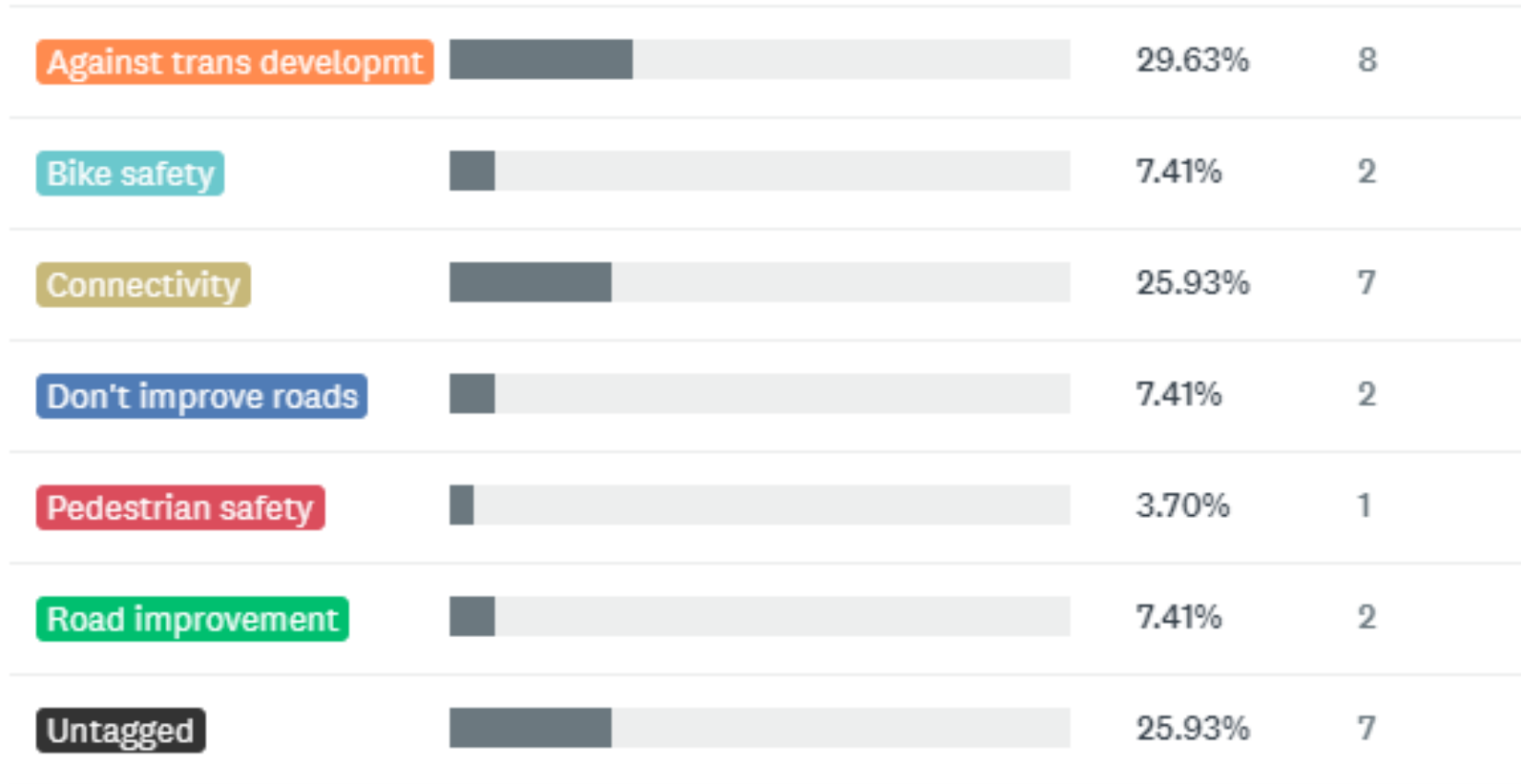

Q40 – How important are the following transportation-related features and amenities?

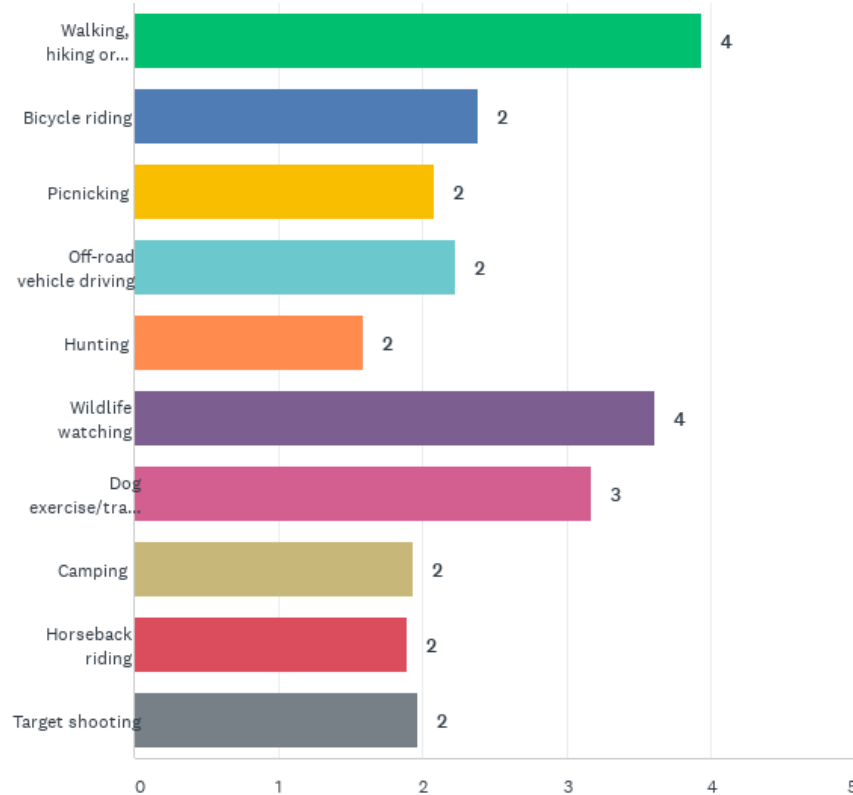

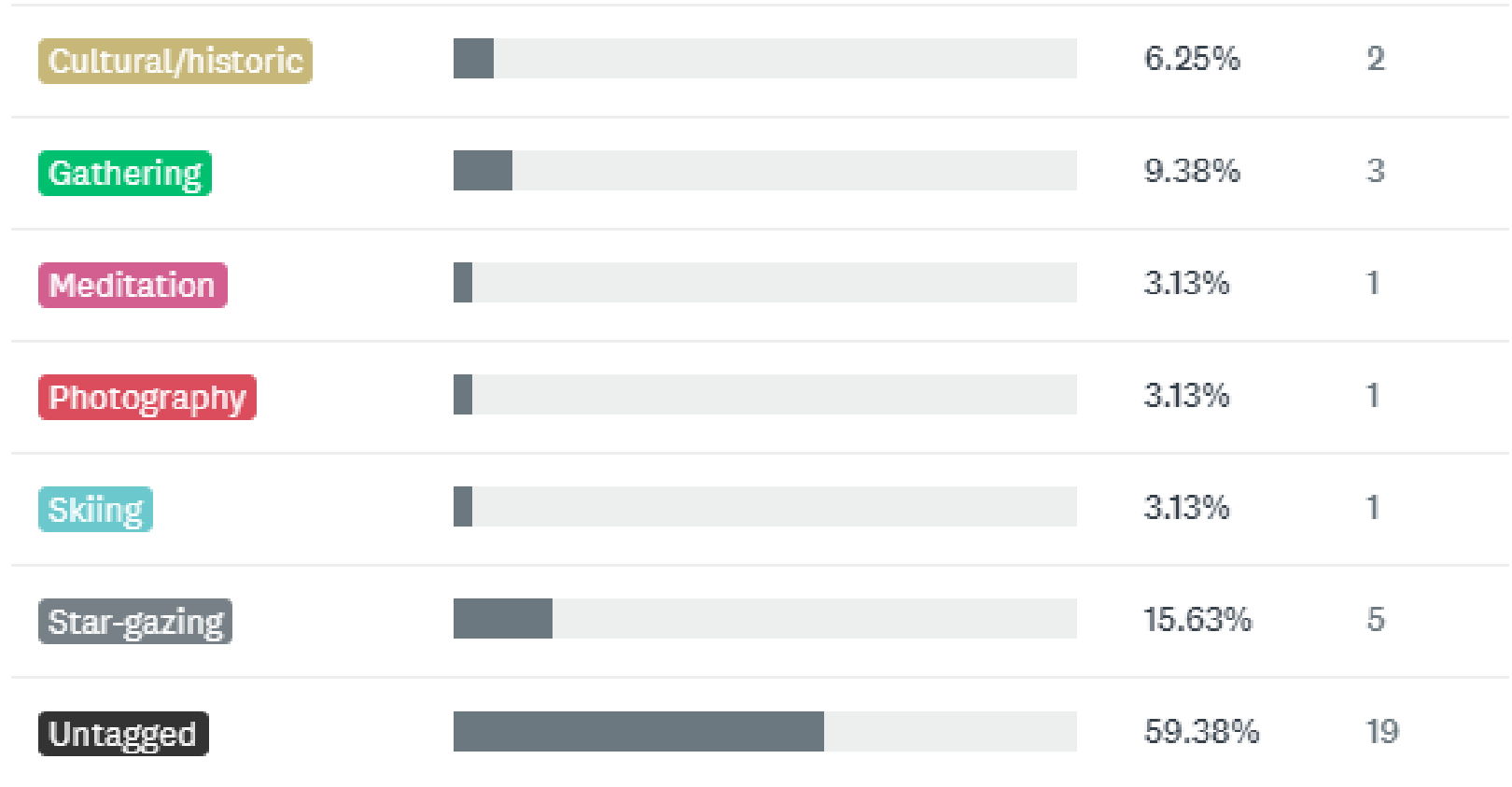
Q41 How often do members of your household use the National Forest system adjacent to DPTF, and what do you do there? Please check a frequency for each activity that applies to members of your household.

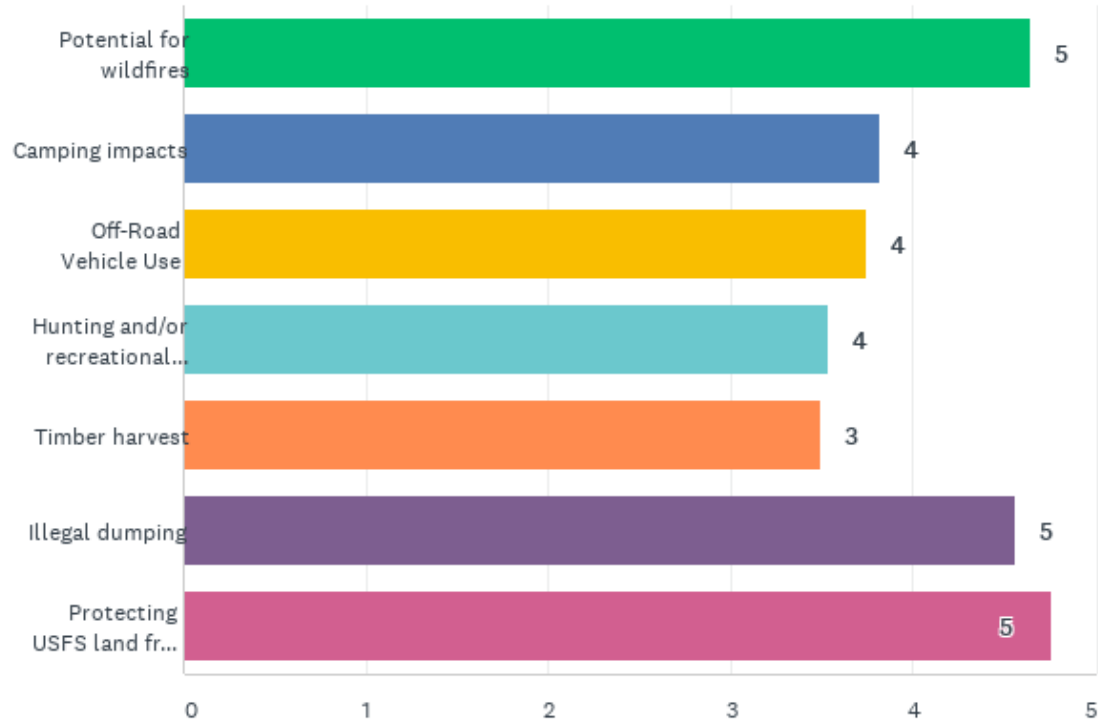
Q41 – How often do members of your household use the USFS system, and what do you do there? Other = 32



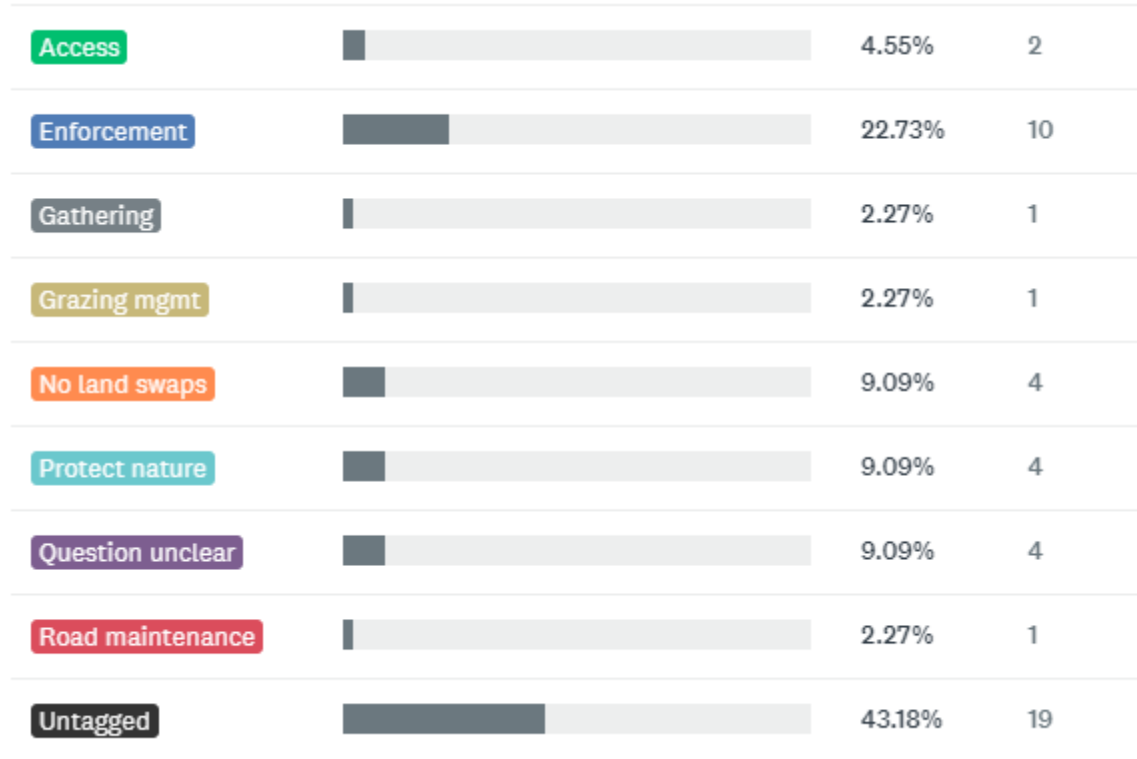

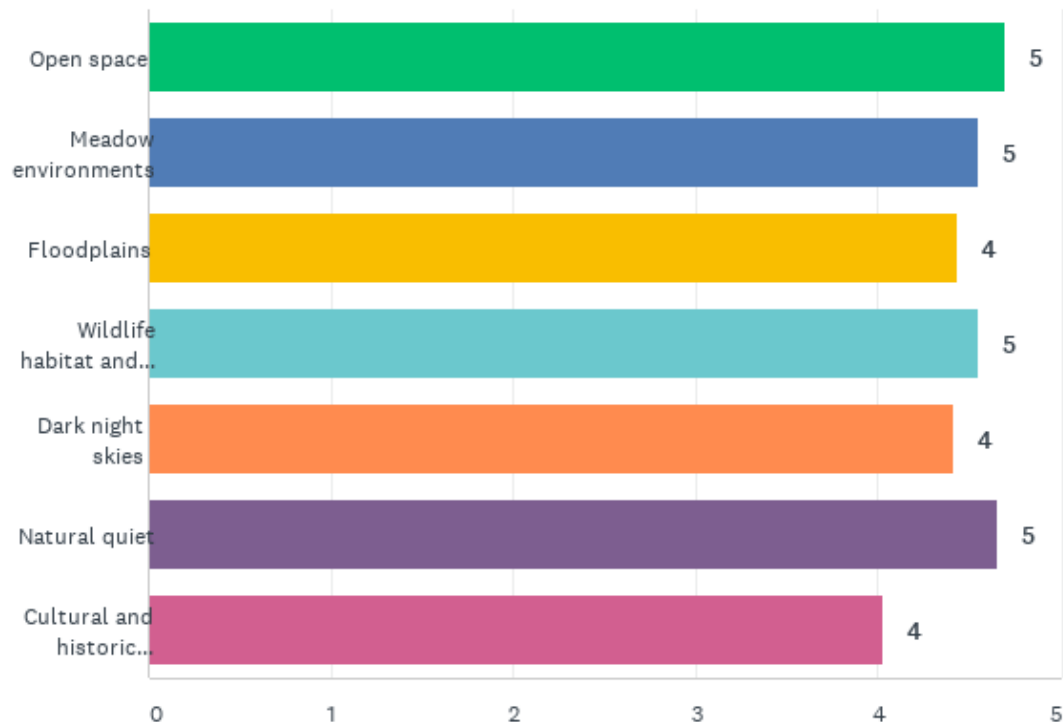
Q42 - Rank the following issues related to National Forest management. Other = 44



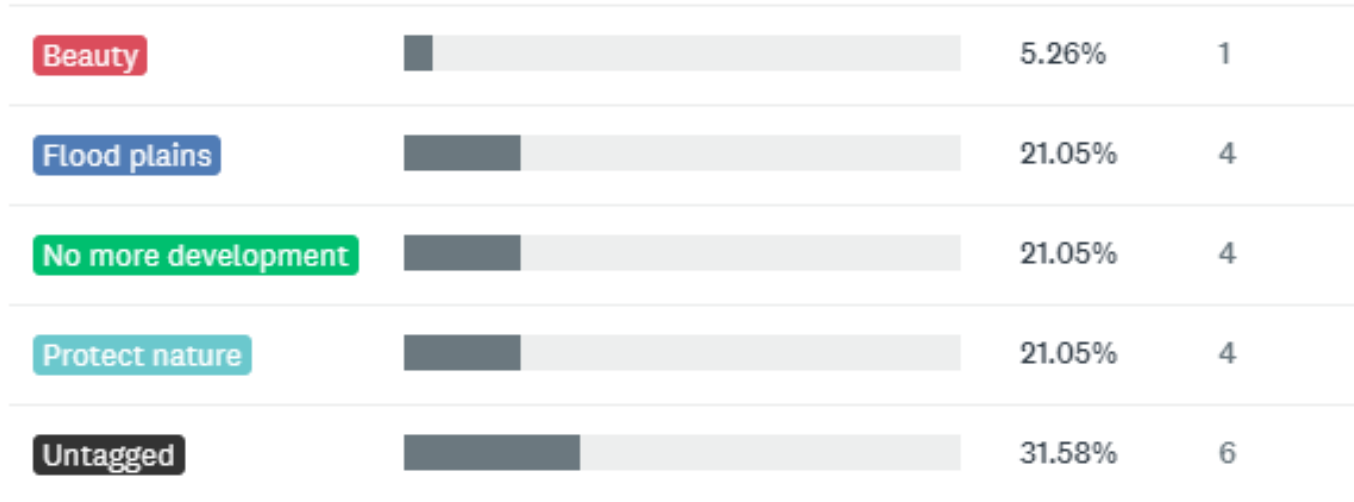
