Phase B of the project includes the construction of a roundabout and development of an alternative business access to improve traffic circulation for trucks, businesses, travelers and residents.

Banicki Construction is scheduled to work during daylight hours, Monday through Friday with some weekend work possible. Flaggers, signage and other traffic controls will be used to guide vehicles through the work zone. Drivers should expect delays during construction and plan travel accordingly.

Phase B of the project is expected to be completed by this fall; however, this schedule is subject to change due to weather or other unforeseen conditions.

The **Bellemont Access and Safety Improvements Project** will address traffic flow and safety issues at the intersection of Transwestern Road, Shadow Mountain Drive and Brannigan Park Road in Bellemont. The project, which will tie into Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) right of way, is being built in two phases.
